

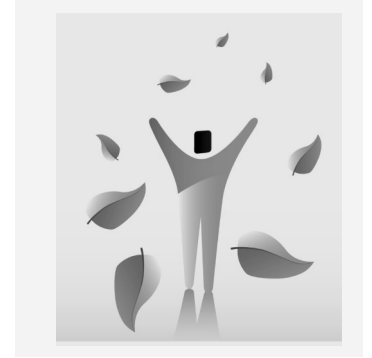

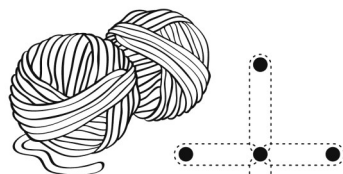

CROSS CRAFT

Make this special cross as a reminder
of Jesus' death and resurrection.



What you need:

- Adult help
- Piece of wood
- 5 nails
- Hammer
- 2 balls of yarn
(blue and yellow)

What you do:

1. Hammer the nails into
the wood to form a cross
shape (see example).
2. Tie the blue yarn to the
bottom nail. Wrap it up
and around the top nail
and back down to the
bottom nail. Then wrap
it around the middle nail
and around the side nails.
Repeat until the yarn is
wrapped about halfway
up the exposed nails.
3. Repeat step two with
the yellow yarn. Wrap it
around the nails until
only the heads are visible.

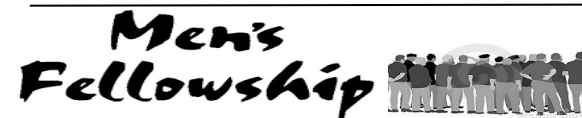

Pastor's message..



God's love never ends...

Upon watching the film "A Wrinkle in Time", based on the book by Madeline L'Engle, I was reminded about the power of love. In this story a young woman learns how love is the most powerful force in all of creation. This Easter, we also are reminded that love overcomes all opposition in Jesus resurrection. This Jesus, who suffered and died, will also rise again.

"... the love that made him (Jesus) suffer all this - it passes as far beyond all his pains as heaven is above earth. For the passion was a deed done in time by the working of love; but the love is without beginning and is, and ever shall be, without end." (Julian of Norwich)



Through the power of love, JESUS IS RISEN! *1 Corinthians 13:13, reminds us of the fullness of love's power...* And now these three remain: faith, hope and love. But the greatest of these is love.

World Water Day

A day for water? Something we all take so for granted? In many parts of the world, water is scarce, or what is available is contaminated or unsanitary. Globally, 1.8 billion people – that's about one out of every four people – drink from contaminated water sources. Unsafe water leads to illnesses that claim the lives of 840,000 people each year, almost half of whom are children under the age of 5. What's more, women and children spend hours each day collecting water. This keeps them from school, work, and time with family. This keeps families and communities from learning, earning an income, and contributing to the local economy. To bring attention to this crisis, ELCA World Hunger has set March 22 as World Water Day. Clean water is one of the most powerful ways to create change in the world. When a community gains access to clean water, close to home, everything changes. Women don't spend hours gathering water. They are healthier than ever. They can work and farm. Earn money and grow food. Send their children to school. Support the local economy. And then teach neighbors how to do the same.

World Hunger helps in places like the CAR:

In China, irrigation canals are dug so crops can prosper. In Zimbabwe, toilets are installed to help prevent the spread of disease.

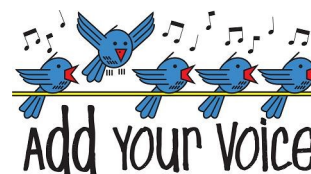

Feb 19, 2018 and urged that we consider what we can do ministry-wise in each location. For example, what are some of the positives about each building and how are they connected to the Mission of TOL? He urges us to think into the future and let Ministry – Mission – Location be the deciding factors in our final decision.

Real Estate Review: In February, all of Tree of Life Churches property was walked through by a local real estate company to determine the general Assessed Values of our property and a history of what other local church properties have been sold for in the Jamestown area. In recent history, purchased church buildings have sold from 83-180 thousand dollars. Assessment values are higher than actual sales income. However, the following numbers are what this real estate current assessment figured:

825 Forest Ave—120-180 thousand	\$720,000
556 E 2nd St — 100-120 thousand	\$680,000

Within the Vision team a Real Estate Team was established to work on upcoming real estate review duties. (Kimberly Hagelin and Pastor)

Tree of Life Vision Team Update - April 2018

The Tree of Life Church Vision Team, Melissa Storms, David Eaker, Steve Sandberg, Darcy Whitney, Dorie Deyo, Kimberly Hagelin and Pastor Eastman; is working on clarifying and expanding upon our current mission statement:

Tree of Life Church: united in worship, sharing Jesus and serving all people.

The team has met twice since its assembly in February. Last month we studied the parable of the Prodigal Son (Luke 15:11-31) looking to this Bible text to define how we are to move forward as Tree of Life church. After praying, reading and studying this text, the Vision Team members worked together to interpret this parable's meaning and message to Tree of Life Church today. According to this group work, the message of the Bible Text to TOL from this parable is:

As a new church: God is calling us to change, forgive, embrace, move forward and reach out in celebration as children of God.

The parable of the Prodigal Son and our mission statement focused on: worship, service and outreach; is the lens that we use to look at the information and data that we've collected from our Church Vitality Survey, a real estate property review and the building review by ELCA's Mission Investment Fund.

Mission Investment Fund Review:

Everyone on the Vision Team had read the outline from Jeff Spann, Church Building Consultant, Mission/Investment Fund of the ELCA, dated Feb 20, 2018. It was noted that he previously visited the TOL Church Buildings in 2014 and was invited for a return visit by Pastor Eastman.

His suggestions focused on the pros and cons of each facility to enhance the current and future ministries of our congregation. His suggestions will be considered by the Vision Team during future discussions and evaluations.

It was noted that Mr. Spann personally addressed the Council on
