MINUTES 6-23-16

The JCGC met at the 1st Presbyterian Church on June 23rd, 2016. The meeting was called to order by our president, Tony Steirs at 7:10 PM. Livingston Kelley read the minutes from the last meeting, Karen Dean moved acceptance, Doug Oxford 2nd, and the motion carried.

Tony told the club about the 10 new JCGC members from the Smokey Mt. H. S. men's golf club. They will be able to play in all tournaments with JCGC but will NOT participate in the \$12 pot. They will pay NO membership dues, but scores will be turned in to CGA for handicaps. A ladies golf team will soon be established at SMHS and they will have the same privileges.

Tom Tabor moved acceptance, Tom Dill 2nd, and the motion passed.

Tony passed out updated Match Play schedules thru July 10.

Tom Tabor announced that Todd Vinyard, of the Sylva Herald, is writing an article about JCGC. There was a picture taken of all members present at the last tournament play at SMCC, 6-20-16. The article should be out soon.

Tony Steirs brought up the 95 Rule, (age + handicap = 95. If you fall into the 95 Rule, you can play from the senior tees.) . He explained the USGA Handigram explaining section 3-5. In it, all golfers would play with the handicap based on their index x the slope of the tee box they want to play from. This figure when divided by 113 will equal their handicap for THAT set of tee boxes. This number is rounded to the nearest whole number.

If we use this format, anyone can play from any tee box they want, within their gender.

Bill Hambling moved to abandon the 95 rule. DAVE ALLISON 2nd and the motion carried.

Tom Dill moved that club members may play from any tee that is USGA rated for that persons gender. Handicaps will be adjusted by USGA rules in Section 3-5. DAVE ALLISON 2nd and the motion carried.

Bill Hambling asked about handicaps in match play. Tony Steirs said they would be calculated by Section 3-5 from now on.

Bill Stump asked about slow play. Toney Steirs said that the problem should be corrected with Section 3-5 handicap revision.

Bill Stump moved to adjourn, Bill Hambling 2nd, and the motion carried.
