4.0 Membership & Treasurer Report - Chuck Murphey KI6CM

5.0 January Presentation

Peter Mason N6ERL, NCARC Vice President and ARES Emergency Coordinator presented an extensive overview of the history and present status of NCARC ARES. ARES is the ARRL Amateur Radio Emergency Service. ARES is organized at national, state, district and local levels and has agreements with many government and public service organization. ARES nets use the FEMA Incident Control system (ICS). NCARC ARES is now recognized by Nevada County Office of Emergency Services (OES) in the event of a local emergency requiring ham radio communications. ARES stations use voice and Winlink without any local public services (power, internet, cell phone, etc.). NCARC ARES has many levels of participation and in the event of a local emergency will operate the local W6DD repeater net. Even if you are not participating in NCARC ARES, should a local emergency occur, you can monitor the net and possibly get or provide helpful information under net control.
