

Bee Artful Poster Project 2022

Step1: Buy and Cut

Bee Artful plans to repeat a very fun challenge we did in 2010. Participation is totally optional but if you join the fun, you must commit to complete your parts.

Purchase a poster of your choice no larger than 24"x30" of landscape or portrait orientation. Choose one that you like that has fairly simple shapes that can be duplicated in fused fabric applique and embellishments as appropriate for the design. Don't make it too difficult! www.allposters.com and www.zazzle.com have huge collections, Walmart and Joann's and others have posters on-line so keep your eye out for one you like. Order now to ensure there is time for shipping.

Take a photo of it but do not share it or show anyone your poster. The mystery is part of the fun! You may choose to buy a second one to help you assemble it when you get the pieces back.

Straight cut one of your posters into **four pieces**, irregular shapes are much more fun than a rectangle or square. Put your initials on the back of each piece in a corner where it is not noticeable for the drawing of the pieces.

Take your poster pieces to the March meeting where we will lay all of them face-down onto a large table and mix them up like Scrabble dies. (You may send your pieces with someone who will not peak and she will add yours to the pile and pull your pieces for you.)

We will take turns drawing one piece from the pile, keeping them face down. Observe the initials and return any piece back to the pile if you get one with the same initials or your own and draw another immediately.

We'll continue to go around the table pulling a piece at a time until you have the same number of pieces you contributed. Each piece will be from a different poster.

When all the pieces have been claimed, Bev will create a chart of each poster noting who has each piece so we'll know who is responsible for each part of each poster.

You will then take your pieces home and attempt to recreate your section to exact scale, matching the color and details. Bev will give specific instructions for making your pieces in March so you'll know how to proceed so the pieces will fit together perfectly when they are returned.

You have until October to create your pieces. Take them to the October meeting. What fun it will be to match up the sections for each poster and see how well the original poster was recreated by your friends.
