THIRD GRADE MODIFIES MARDI GRAS PARADE!!

Where There's a Will, There's a Way! The impact of pandemic has reached worldwide, including the Maurepas Third Graders' little corner. Traditionally, third graders design and create a Mardi Float each year then partner with Mr. Fred's seventh graders who assist them with the actual construction and pulling of the floats during the parade. Due to restrictions and safety considerations, this year had to be a bit different. While the third graders were not able to host the annual parade or have seventh grade assistants, they designed an "Outside-In" Mardi Gras Float which was displayed on the stage for all the school to see.

The third graders created their "Outside-In" floats by creating copier paper box dioramas with their chosen Mardi Gras themes. Each student brought in found items from home and created a backdrop inside the copier paper box. Each student told the class the title of their designs and the nature of their creative process and connection to Louisiana's cultural tradition of Mardi Gras.


