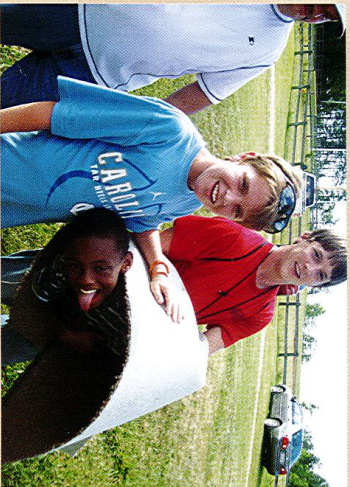


SCHEDULE

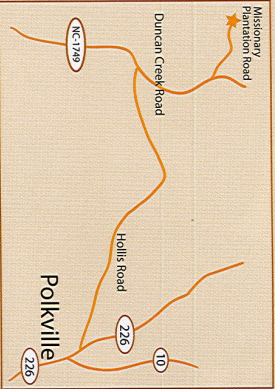
For the parent/guardian:

DIRECTIONS

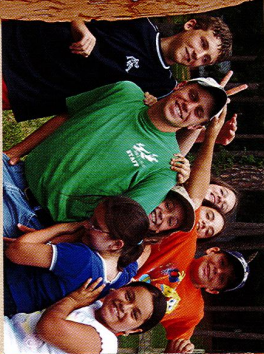
From Charlotte Area:
 Take I-85 South to Exit 108I Hwy. 74 West. Go through Shelby, take Hwy. 226 North to Polkville. Just past stop light in Polkville, bear left continuing on 226 North. Then take second road to left onto Hollis Road. Go approximately 5 miles, turn Right onto Durcan Creek Rd. Go 2 miles and turn Left onto Missionary Plantation Road. Go one mile, this runs into Harvest Time Bible Camp.
