## THE BOARDMAN SPARTAN MARCHING BAND

It happens time and time again to people in their travels across the country and abroad when they mention Boardman, Ohio... "That's the place with that great marching band, isn't it?" The Boardman Spartan Marching Band is well-known. Its reputation for size, quality, entertainment value, and a tradition of musical excellence has been going strong for decades. There is no other student group of any kind in the Boardman Schools and the outlying communities as large or as steeped in tradition as the BSMB. Audiences are repeatedly amazed at the high-quality music, marching, and theatrical production of every performance.

The Band has appeared on national television in the **Tournament of Roses Parade**, **Macy's Thanksgiving Day Parade**, **Gimbel's Thanksgiving Day Parade**, the **Target Thanksgiving Parade**, the **Sunkist Fiesta Bowl Parade**, the **Citrus Bowl Parade**, the **Indianapolis 500 Parade**, and the **Orange Bowl Parade**. The Band has also performed in New York City's **St. Patrick's Day and Nations Parades**, Norfolk, Virginia's **International Azalea Festival Parade of Nations**, **The Shenandoah Apple Blossom Festival Parade**, and **The National Cherry Blossom Festival Parade**. In 2004, the *BSMB* was honored to perform for President George W. Bush during his campaign stop in the valley. The Band has had numerous performances professional sports teams including: Cleveland Browns, Pittsburgh Steelers, Cincinnati Bengals, Washington Redskins, Buffalo Bills, Cleveland Indians, Cleveland Cavaliers, Toronto Argonauts, Hamilton Tiger-Cats, Michigan Panthers, Pittsburgh Maulers, Mahoning Valley Phantoms, and Detroit Tigers. The band was a special guest high school band at an Ohio State University Marching Band "Skull Session," and was specially selected to participate in the opening ceremonies of the 2009 **Indianapolis 500** and the **500 Festival Parade**. The 2012 season included a nationally broadcast appearance in the **McDonald's Thanksgiving Parade** in Chicago. The current edition of the BSMB entertained over 80,000 spectators in Gatlinburg, Tennessee's "Fantasy of Lights" Christmas Parade.

High visibility is considered part of every performance. The Band cannot be ignored when moving from place to place in eight school buses or five charter coaches. The uniforms attract attention mostly because of the eight-inch Busby hats that each member carries in a five-gallon bucket. Frequency of performance also adds to the Band's visibility. The BSMB maintains the busiest schedule of any band around. A typical seasonal schedule includes at least ten high school football games, one professional sporting event, three local "Band Nights," one national parade, and dozens of community parades and events.

In addition to the BSMB, the Boardman High School Band Program is proud to offer its students many other performance opportunities including four award-winning concert bands, three jazz ensembles, pep band, basketball band, percussion ensemble, and many small ensembles.

These and other aspects of the Music Department earned Boardman High School the designation as a 2007 **Grammy Signature School**. BHS was one of only 18 schools in the entire country – and the only one in Ohio – to hold this great honor. Boardman was also on the 2006 and 2009 lists of the **100 Best Communities for Music Education in America**.
