In the past year, the Calico Rock Museum Foundation has:

- strengthened our museum exhibits and art gallery
- expanded our educational programming
- increased our community outreach through special project funding
- served nearly 23,000 visitor contacts including approximately 10,000 actual visitors and 10,000 website visitors
- published the first community history entitled, *Calico Rock: a history from 1831 to 1966*, which has sold over 200 copies since mid-November, 2012

Since 2008, the foundation has:

- raised over \$200,000 in funds to support our mission and programs
- established the Calico Rock Museum & Visitor Center
- served over 50,000 visitors

Since July, 2010, the foundation has:

- received over \$120,000 in actual cash contributions for our building campaign
- secured commitments for 93% of the building project costs
- cut our building purchase loan debt by 3/4 from \$80,000 to \$20,000

At the end of 2011, the foundation entered into a contract for visitor center services with the city of Calico Rock. The foundation has demonstrated proven leadership in management and operation of the Calico Rock Museum & Visitor Center.

It has been an amazing year, but it could not have happened without your support. As a donor and leader in this effort, you have made a tremendous difference to the foundation and our community.

In 2013, the community will celebrate the 110th anniversary of the construction of the railroad at Calico Rock, the 110th anniversary of the first passenger train to arrive at Calico Rock, the 110th anniversary of the building of upper Main Street (including the 110th anniversary of our building), and the 90th anniversary of the rebuilding of lower Main Street following the devastating fire of 1923.

We look forward to expanding our educational programming and the continuous enhancement of our exhibits.

Statement on Financial Condition

The foundation entered into a contract with the city of Calico Rock to provide museum and visitor center services which has strengthened our long-term financial condition. This contract enables the foundation to continue to staff the center for the foreseeable future. The foundation has lowered overall debt to the point where it is capitalized to nearly 5 times more than overall debt. The foundation continues to show strength in donations, especially among small donors.

The financial condition of the Calico Rock Museum Foundation, Inc. is strong due to the prudent management decisions by the officers, executive committee, and board of trustees. The foundation is well-positioned for the future.

Educational Programming Activities

School Tours and Programs

In 2012, the museum welcomed a number of school groups from Calico Rock Elementary, Calico Rock High School, Norfork Elementary School, and Flippin Elementary School. The students toured the museum and engaged in educational programming related to specific topics addressed in the museum which meet Arkansas history frameworks.

Public Programs and Classes

In 2012, the museum held a number of public programs, crafting demonstrations, and classes on various topics related to the history and art of Calico Rock. These included pottery, candle-making, woodcarving, painting, and other crafting demonstrations. The programs also included classes on canning, soap-making, candle-making, one-room schools, and general stores.

Art Exhibits

The museum hosted a clothesline art exhibit for work submitted by every student at Calico Rock Elementary School. In addition, the museum hosted exhibits of works by Emma Drown Morgan, Laura Brooke Barksdale, and Bill Jarosz.

Native American Day

The most successful event in the history of the museum has been the Native American Day held in September, 2012. The event included the opening of the Native American exhibit, including a wiki hut and log cabin interactive exhibit. The event included a demonstration of Native American dance. Over 1,500 people attended the celebration.

The Storybook Project

The Storybook Project is a special project of the Calico Rock Museum Foundation. Volunteers go into the North Central Unit of the Arkansas Department of Corrections to allow inmates to record themselves reading a book to their child. The recordings and the books are then mailed to the children, so they can hear their incarcerated parent reading to them.

The hope for the project is to improve the literacy and love of reading in the children, strengthen the reading skills of inmates, and provide an invaluable connection between the incarcerated parent and their child.

On June 5, 2012 the first Storybook Project recordings were made at the North Central Unit. Twenty-five inmates participated. The second recordings were made on October 16, 2012 with twenty-six inmates participating. A total of 81 children have been served through this project.

The next recordings will be made on April 9, 2013. The goal is to double the number of inmates participating in the program in 2013.
