Here's another week of various topics to share with you:

1. You may remember that I said I would have homilies about how the schools and parishes are doing generally and financially. Please give him your support and cooperation as he takes this important role for our parishes. I would also like to thank our previous Athletic Directors Jim Glauer and Cody Gosser for the time they gave to leading our Panthers athletic program. In addition, a big thank you for all those who volunteer to coach our teams and those who show up to cheer for our teams. Your support is very much appreciated.
3. We have a Holy Day of Obligation Mass this week- The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary into Heaven. We will have a Vigil Mass on Wednesday August 14 at Sacred Heart parish at 6:30 p.m. There will be a morning Mass on Thursday August 15 at 8:30 a.m. at St. Joseph parish. There is a sporting event you want to see. You want to go see a movie or watch Netflix. Your pet will be too sad without you. You get the picture what the Lord wants you to do.
4. It is hard to believe but both Sacred Heart and St. Joseph will begin school next week. Sacred Heart will begin on Tuesday August 20 and St. Joseph will begin on Thursday August 22. The summer always seems to go the fastest of all the seasons! Parents get your kids ready for another school year of faith, facts, and fellowship.
