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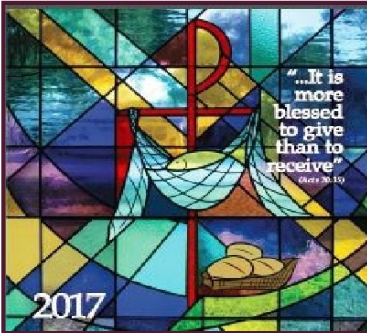

†SAINTS/FEASTS OF THE WEEK†

Nov. 21-Presentation of the Blessed Virgin Mary

In thanksgiving for the gift of their daughter, Mary's parents, Joachim and Anne, brought her to the Temple in Jerusalem to consecrate her to God.

Nov. 22-St. Cecilia—The daughter of a wealthy Roman family, a Christian from birth, was promised in marriage to a pagan named Valerian. Cecilia had vowed her virginity to God, and wore sackcloth, fasted and prayed in hopes of keeping this promise. Patroness of musicians.

Nov. 23 –St. Clement I—Considered the first Apostolic Father of the Church, he is said to have been consecrated by Saint Peter, and is known to have been a leading member of the church in Rome in the late 1st century.

St. Columban—The greatest of the Irish missionaries who worked on the European continent, Columban established several monasteries in Europe which became centers of religion and culture.

Bl. Miguel Agustin Pro—A Mexican Jesuit Catholic priest executed under the presidency of Plutarco Elías Calles on charges of bombing and attempted assassination of former Mexican President Álvaro Obregón.

Nov. 24 –St. Andrew Dung-Lac and Companions

—A Catholic convert ordained to the priesthood, was one of 117 people martyred in Vietnam between 1820 and 1862. Members of the companions group gave their lives for Christ in the 17th, 18th, and 19th centuries, and received beatification during four different occasions between 1900 and 1951. All were canonized during the papacy of Saint John Paul II.

Nov. 25 –St. Catherine of Alexandria—Converted to Christianity after receiving a vision, she debated 50 pagan philosophers who were so amazed at her wisdom and debating skills, they became Christian, as did about 200 soldiers and members of the emperor's family. All of them were martyred.

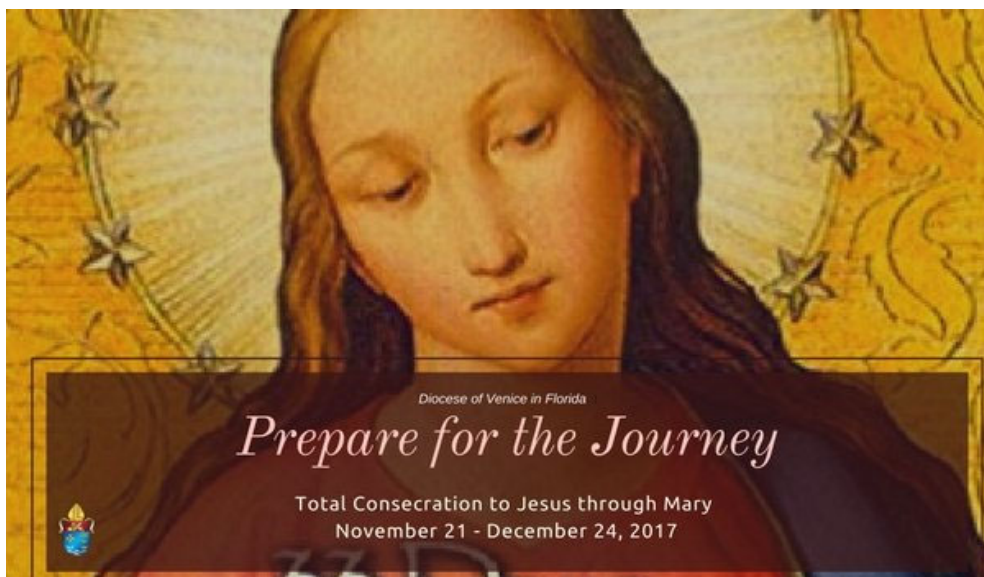

El patrón en la parábola de los tres empleados puede escucharse severo, hasta que reflexionamos la historia desde su perspectiva. Era su dinero. Él había confiado su dinero a sus empleados. Ellos obviamente sabían que era lo que se esperaba de ellos y dos cumplieron bien su responsabilidad. El patrón fue sabio al confiarles su tesoro. Por medio de su fiel administración corresponsable, el tesoro se incrementó. Escuchando esta parábola desde esta perspectiva, debemos considerar el significado de Jesús al contarla. No sabemos cuándo nuestro patrón, Cristo nuestro Señor, regresará. Lo que sí sabemos es que Dios nos ha confiado muchos dones y espera que seamos buenos y fieles administradores corresponsables con ellos.

EL EMPLEADO

A los empleados de la parábola se les confió la riqueza del patrón. Los talentos no eran suyos, aun así, se les pidió que hicieran fructificarlos en la ausencia de su patrón. Se esperaba que trataran los talentos como si

fueran de ellos. Nuestros dones: vida, talentos, recursos financieros y materiales, le pertenecen a Dios. Se nos han confiado estos dones y se espera que se les dé un buen uso, para que así sea conocida la presencia de Dios en el mundo. Como la mujer en el pasaje de hoy del libro de los Proverbios, “debemos trabajar con manos hábiles” para dar una mano a los necesitados y socorrer a los pobres (Proverbios 31:20) por la forma en como usamos el tiempo, recursos, talentos y dones que Dios no ha confiado. Pon atención que el tercer trabajador en la parábola del Evangelio, miedoso y perezoso, no malgastó su talento, simplemente lo enterró. ¿Qué talento, don o recurso estás usando bien? ¿Qué don has enterrado? Es tiempo de desenterrarlo, desempolvarlo y empezar a usarlo como “hijos de la luz y el día” (1 tesalonicenses 5:6).

TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITION

Earlier this autumn, we looked at how our Eucharistic Prayers have been enriched by the approval of several new prayers to augment the old Roman Canon. For us, there are the four standard prayers, three for Masses with Children, and the most recent addition, the former Swiss Eucharistic Prayer with four alternative forms (now known as the Eucharistic Prayer for Masses for Various Needs and Occasions).

We also have two Eucharistic Prayers for Masses of Reconciliation. The source for these two prayers is the request by many bishops for a special prayer for the "Holy Year" of 1975. Originally, the committee in charge was commissioned to write a single prayer, but the theme proved so rich that it gave rise to two. The first is based on and develops biblical texts on reconciliation. The second starts with the experience of living in today's fractured world, and how the Spirit calls us to reconciliation and peace. Not everyone was happy with all this creativity, saying that if too many were published, it would be difficult for the Vatican to control further requests. Everyone thought the pope would put strict limits on the prayers, but in the end he said he was willing to open doors that had long been closed. Although he approved them for a period of only three years, they were never formally removed from the *Sacramentary* and have been incorporated into the new Roman Missal. —Rev. 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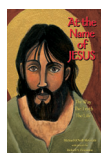
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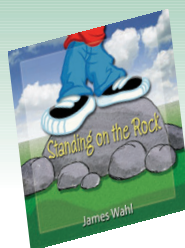
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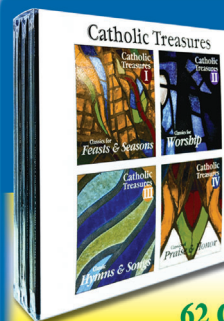


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
