<u>24/03824/TCONR</u> Sunny House, Naunton Reduce 1 conifer by 3 m, reduce 4 yews by 1m. Comment of 'Naunton PC has no objections' posted. Councillors to confirm this is an accurate reflection of their views.

<u>24/03471/TCONR</u> Maintenance to beech at The Old Rectory, Church Lane Naunton. Decision: No objections.

<u>24/02355/FUL</u> Formation of a 3 furlong all-weather oval gallop, Summerhill Farm, Naunton Cheltenham Gloucestershire GL54 3AZ. Decision: Refused, due to *"Insufficient information has been submitted to demonstrate the biodiversity gain objective can be met and the biodiversity gain condition can be successfully discharged in accordance with Schedule 7A of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 (as inserted by Schedule 14 of the Environment Act)."* 

- 6) Dog waste disposal. Councillors to consider emails (see Clerk's Report) from a resident regarding disposal of dog waste and decide on any appropriate action.
- 7) CPRE campaign in support of the Climate and Nature Bill. This bill strongly supports achievement of the 1.5% global warming goal. See Clerks report for details. Councillors to decide whether to support the bill by writing to the local MP.
- 8) **Speeding**. Cllr Gibberson to report on progress of village survey. Councillors to decide on further action.
- **9)** Neighbourhood Development Plan. Cllr Gibberson to report on progress. Councillors to decide on further action.
- **10)** Internal Financial Controls. At the November meeting, ClIrs Pickup and Russell agreed to carry out the Internal Financial Controls review. Councillors to note results and decide on any changes required. The previous policy did not provide steps for online payment checking. The

policy has been amended to include how to check online payments and the wording is included in the Clerk's report. Councillors to decide whether to accept proposed new process.
