Dear Neighbours

Thank you for donating to the Richmond Food Bank 30 cases of noodles given you by Air Canada.

Your gifts are essential to providing reliable year-round service as we receive no public funding. Yet with your support, our volunteers give grocery assistance to 600 households in a typical week. During our distributions, we also offer Nutritious Recipe Demonstrations, Play & Learn for preschool children and their parents, Ageless Volunteerism that partners teens with seniors, and our Information Table and Wellness Centre where qualified volunteers, student nurses, and visiting service agencies connect people in need with community resources.

With your help we are conducting seven weekly distributions in four locations across the city, including a special time for recent refugees who need interpreters to help register and choose foods, as well as working with Richmond schools who are addressing hunger among students and their families. The Richmond Food Bank is also a receiving hub, distributing food and supplies to community meals, shelters, a drop-in centre, and other agencies that serve people in transition – extending our reach to more people needing help through a rough time.
