

2020 Verde Valley Fair April 29th to May 3rd, 2020 Organized Youth RV Rules & Regulations

A limited number of RV spaces are available for the exclusive use of Verde Valley Fair Organized Youth Families. Priority will be given to members of the fair association. The following rules and regulations govern the Verde Valley Fair's RV parking area.

- 1. To be eligible for an RV space, you must have a child enrolled in a Verde Valley Fair Organized Youth project. Only members in good standing will be issued an RV space. There will be a fee of **\$35.00** per rented space for member of VVF, non-members will be \$65 per space.
- 2. RV space allocations will be given on a first-come, first-served basis, priority given to Verde Valley Fair Association members. RV spaces will be located in a fenced area in the front parking lot.
- 3. Each RV is required to have a minimum of one adult supervisor who must be present with exhibitors in the RV area from 8:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m. **NO EXCEPTIONS**.
- 4. RV supervisor must be an adult who is a parent/guardian, leader or advisor. All adult supervisors with an RV will be required to sign an Affidavit of the rules.
- 5. RV supervisor is responsible for the enforcement of all RV rules for their RV.
- 6. One RV and one vehicle per marked space. **ONLY**
- 7. RV must be in the space assigned by the Verde Valley Fair Management. The RV may be removed from the Fairgrounds by Management.
- 8. A regulation identification card provided by the Verde Valley Fair Management must be affixed to the inside of a window so that the information on the card is visible at all times throughout the Verde Valley Fair, beginning at 2:00 p.m., Wednesday, April 29, 2020.
- 9. The Verde Valley Fair may remove any RV not having the Verde Valley regulation identification card in the proper location.
- 10. RVs must have a holding tank. DO NOT DRAIN GREY WATER ONTO GROUND!
- 11. Generators are not to be run after 10:00 p.m. or before 6:00 a.m.
- 12. No horse RVs will be allowed. (Living Quarters trailers are ok, not just a horse trailer)
- 13. RV spaces are dry camp only. The Verde Valley Fair does not have electrical or water hook-ups available.
- 14. RVs will be pulled onto the Verde Valley Fairgrounds during the assigned times Shorter rigs * April 24 Saturday April 25 until 2 pm. Longer rigs * from 3 pm Saturday April 25 until Sunday April 26 by 7 pm.
- 15. RVs must be in place before 7:00 p.m., Sunday, April 26, 2020. RVs MUST BE REMOVED BY
 4:00 P.M. ON Wednesday, May 6, 2020. A \$15.00 RENTAL FEE CHARGED PER DAY
 WILL BE ASSESSED AFTER May 6, 2020.
- 16. Noise is not permitted after 11:00 p.m.
- 17. No running through other RV spaces.
- 18. Dogs are not allowed in the RV area, as well as throughout the Verde Valley Fairgrounds.
- 19. Any exhibitor who violates the above rules, and the rules of good conduct, will be required to leave the Verde Valley Fairgrounds, and will forfeit any and all premium awards earned at the Verde Valley Fair.
- 20. The Verde Valley Fair Association will take reasonable precautions to protect RVs at the Fair. However, we are not to be held responsible for any loss and/or damage to any RV, including but not limited to, any of the actions and/or activities of the renter and/or any occurrences and/or claims associated with and/or arising out of the renter's activities and/or occupancy of the rental space at the Fair. The space renter agrees to hold the Verde Valley Fair Association, its agents and

employees harmless from any loss, risk, cost and expenses, including but not limited to, attorney's fees, arising out of or relating to this contract.

- 21. The renter accepts total responsibility for their RV and its safety in relation to fire, robbery, accident, and/or other destructive cause, and to injury to the occupants, which might occur within the confines of the space while on the Verde Valley Fairgrounds. The RV owner is responsible at their own expense to hold insurance for which the renter may desire to cover such contingencies.
- 22. Arizona Liquor Laws prohibit bringing alcohol onto the Verde Valley Fairgrounds. Any and all alcohol must be purchased through the Verde Valley Fair Association, Inc. Failure to abide by these laws will nullify this agreement.
- 23. The Verde Valley Fair Association shall have full power in interpretation and enforcement of all terms and rules contained herein, and such further rules and regulations as it shall consider necessary for the proper conduct of the Fair. (Any violation of the rules and/or consider necessary for the proper conduct of the Fair). Any violation of the rules and/or procedures shall result in eviction from the premises and participation in the Fair.
- 24. Due to state liquor regulations, NO OPEN DRINK CONTAINERS OR OUTSIDE FOOD may be brought into controlled licensed premises. Unopened, sealed 20 oz or less water bottles will be allowed. Please finish any other drinks or food you might bring before leaving your car and heading toward the gates. Strollers and wheelchairs are welcome at the Verde Valley Fair (but are not available for rent). Assistive pets only and they have to follow the Service Animal Code of Conduct. There will be an ATM machine located on the grounds for your convenience.
