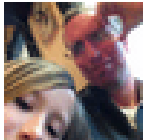
Eugene Public Works continues to operate it's emergency command center (ECC) during snow/ice response. Crews have been at it around the clock since Friday morning.

EMAIL RESPONSES

- Blessing and a curse
 - Messages are delivered to your email inbox so you don't have to sign in to Basecamp to receive messages.
 - However, keep in mind that replying to any Basecamp message (whether from your own email or within Basecamp) will be a **“reply all”**
- Unsubscribing from notifications is available
- If your response is for a subgroup only, forward the message to just those people just like you would a normal message.
