Dear OLSS Families,

I hope everyone got to see our precious saints as they paraded on Monday. This Parade has been a long-standing tradition and even though it looked a little different, I am very glad that the students were able to participate.

I am so thrilled that we have gotten through the  $1^{st}$  quarter. I know it may have been a big transition for some of you but hopefully things have smoothed out. Please do not hesitate to reach out to your child's teacher if at any time your child needs help. An email notification about report card conferences was sent out yesterday. If you feel you need more than 15 minutes you may schedule a conference later.

I am truly grateful for all the fundraising efforts thus far from HSA and our families. In this time of COVID, our fundraising looks different than it usually does. There will be many more quick fundraiser events and not as many social events. I want you to rest assured that the expectation is for you to do what you can. Do not feel pressured to participate in every fundraiser; we have many to appeal to a variety of people.

Please know a lot of thought has gone into the decision to have a Virtual Learning Week after Thanksgiving. Some ADW Schools are virtual from Thanksgiving until January, other chose 2 weeks of virtual learning after Thanksgiving. Luckily, the Catholic Schools Office allowed each district to choose what is best for them, and I think one week of virtual should be long enough to see if anyone might develop symptoms before returning to school. I hope everyone understands that I am trying to do what will keep everyone healthy and safe.

Letters have gone out regarding past due tuition bills. We are at the end of the First Quarter and TADS generates a report letting me know where we stand regarding tuition income. We are approximately \$25,000 behind in unpaid/late promised tuition. Some families are a month behind and other much more. This is of concern as it affects the running of our school. A TADS form letter was sent out to some families.... I figured this would be less invasive than a phone call. I'm sure some of you appreciate that and others may have preferred a phone call. I apologize if I offended anyone. TADS is pretty direct that if you don't pay, you don't attend. The report tells me what is in arrears, not why. I need you to communicate with me so I understand your situation, and if there has been a change in your circumstances since you signed a tuition agreement with Fr. Ken. I value every child and family and I don't want to lose any members. I am more than willing to work with you to resolve your situation, but you must communicate. The operation of the school is contingent on the budget. I am bringing this up today because while I know this does not apply to every family, it does apply to many and next quarter, it may very well apply to you. It is my intention to resolve these issues so that I may pay my teachers and keep the school running smoothly.
