

Undergraduate Student Travel Award in Honor of Dr. Nick Toltl Sponsored by The Analytical Chemistry Division of the CIC

TERMS OF REFERENCE

This award was named in honor of Dr. Nick Toltl on the occasion of his passing in 2017. A long-serving member of the ACD executive, Dr. Toltl was passionate about the education and mentorship of undergraduate students in analytical chemistry.

The intent of the award is to honor outstanding senior undergraduate students in analytical chemistry, to encourage them into postgraduate studies and to expose them to a stimulating scientific environment at the annual Canadian Chemical Conference.

The Undergraduate Student Travel awards are open to all undergraduate students pursuing studies in the area of Analytical Chemistry and in attendance at a Canadian University. The winner is expected to give a poster or oral presentation of his/her work at the 2019 CSC conference.

One award will be given this year, in the form of a travel/conference expense reimbursement up to \$500.

Each research supervisor may nominate one candidate per competition. The application package should contain:

- · a curriculum vitae of the student
- · a copy of the student's academic transcript, and
- one supporting letter (submitted by the supervisor)
