When the puppies are weaned we bring them into the rescue, give them their shots, and get them spayed or neutered and ready for adoption. We make sure to get the mamma dog spayed so as to prevent future unwanted litters of puppies. In some cases we will get the daddy dog fixed as well. It is never our intent to make families get rid of their family pets, but rather to work on making sure no future unwanted pregnancies reoccur.

To that end, we have developed our "Foster to Adopt Puppy Program." When we adopt out a puppy that has not yet been spayed or neutered, the adopter will complete our Foster to Adopt Agreement, a Spay/Neuter Contract, complete our Adoption Contract and the pay the adoption fee in full. The puppy will remain the property of Last Call K9 Rescue until such time as the puppy is spayed or neutered.
