Good morning! Hope all is well.

Toady's clip......'contact caused a violation.' What goes through your mind just reading that....'contact caused a violation'? What SHOULD pop up is we have a potential foul. If *illegal* contact causes a violation, then the contact is illegal and we need to get a foul on it.....

<u>Here</u> are a couple examples...the first one shows illegal contact (defender moving towards the ball handler) causing a back court violation and the second shows (not very well from the camera angle) where contact (a blocking foul) causes a travel.

Today's 'moral of the story' is to get fouls on those plays where illegal contact causes the players to violate (step OOB on that play going down the sideline is common).
