Marine Street Memorial Mall Proposal:

- DDF thanked the BTNA members for their vote; had an impact on result.
 - Referenced correspondence that suggests that the proposal is still alive
- DDF recommended that BTNA routinely follow up with SD Parks and Recreation and review agenda monthly to ensure that any further movement is monitored and that the BTNA has an opportunity to respond; not clear who pledged to perform this routine follow-up (DDF?)

o Barber Tract Street Repair: (MC)

- Westbourne Street is almost done! Next project is Vista Del Mar
 - MC achieved this by going through Barbara Bry's office and persisting in follow-up
 - Suggests that we educate the neighbors about how to deal with city to make repairs and specifically to clarify that it is the homeowner's responsibility to repair sidewalk damage, not the city's, unless the sidewalk damage is caused by the city,
 - Utility under-grounding program: Barber Tract is early in process of under-grounding wires;
 - MC suggested that we ensure that part of the BTNA mission include the all-important focus on improvements to our streets and that we make a concerted effort to identify certain items and outcomes that the BTNA can impact
 - MC to circulate e-mail identifying next two streets that should be addressed
 - MC and Nar to walk neighborhood and check the sidewalks
