

Attention Racers, Crews, Workers & Spectators:

October El Mirage Meet

As you all know, due to Covid-19 things will be different this year. The SCTA had to have a COVID Plan so that we could acquire a permit from the BLM. All of us are here to race and have fun but we need to follow the guidelines/requirements. We are requiring Mandatory masks/face coverings within 6' of others in public areas which include Registration Trailer, Inspection Trailers, Merchandise Trailer, Start Line, Impound and any other Public Area where people cannot social distance at least 6-8 ft. We also have mandatory Covid-19 forms that must be signed. You can either sign them at the Registration Trailer or you can go to our website and print, sign (blue ink) and bring with you and turn them in at the Registration Trailer. We encourage volunteers, entrants & spectators to self-monitor for illness before coming. If you have the following symptoms or signs you should not come to the event: Fever (100.4 °F/38 °C or higher) or chills, Cough that you cannot attribute to another health condition, Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing that you cannot attribute to another health condition, Sore throat that you cannot attribute to another health condition, Muscle aches that you cannot attribute to another health condition, or that may have been caused by a specific activity (such as physical exercise) & loss of taste or smell.

To reiterate, this event will have requirements that everyone should understand. Masks & Social Distancing are Required. If you do not want to do this for any reason, we are asking that you do not attend this event. It has taken a lot of work to get these two events approved and we have to abide by the requirements.

Just a reminder...There will be No Food Vendor at this event. You must bring all your own food, water, etc....
