

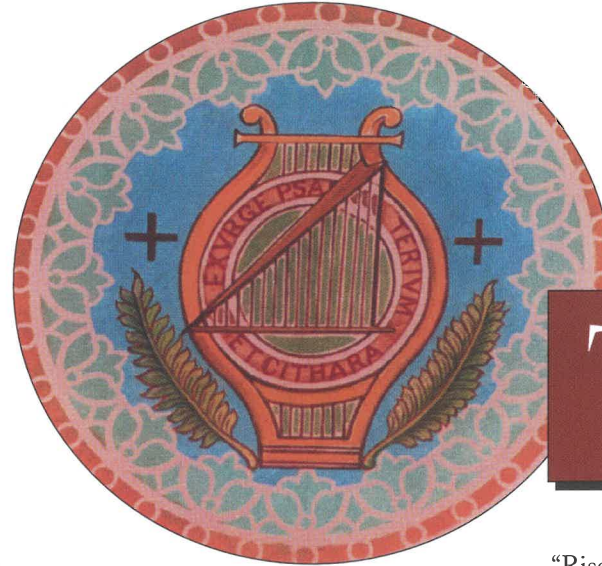

The Lord judges all the nations of the world.”

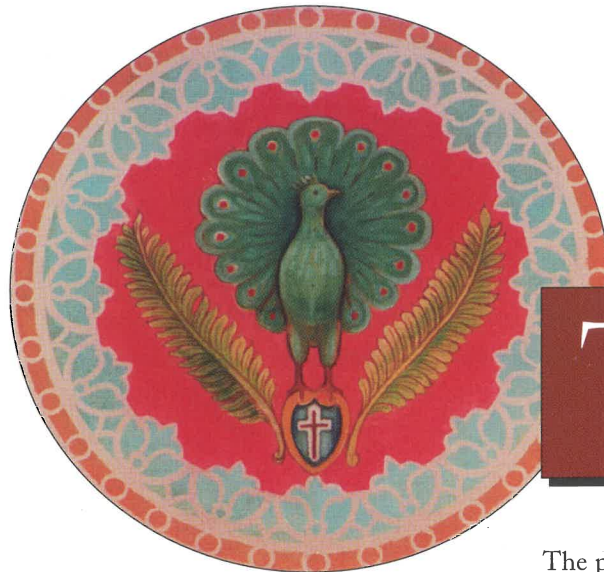


T
