Obedience and Rally Class Order

Jump heights are required to be specified on your entry form. Class order will be ascending from lowest to highest jump heights in all classes in which jumps are used. **Please note running order above. Some classes will start earlier in the day . Event 1704 will start before Event 1703 .**Rally Event 1706 will run **before** Rally Event 1707 on Saturday.

Entry Fees

Entry fee is \$26 for the first Obedience/Rally entry of a dog in a regular, preferred, or optional titling class. Second entry for same dog, same trial is \$16, third entry for same dog, same trial is \$14. Each trial is a separate event. Entry fee for Junior Handlers is \$10 for each class. Please make checks or money orders payable to **CATC**.

Please note the \$16/14 additional entry fees for the same dog only applies to the same dog entered in the same trial. Saturday's Obedience Event 1703 and Event 1704 are separate trials. Rally and Obedience are separate trials.

An Open B/Utility B entry for the same trial is \$42, \$84 for both Saturday trials. The entry fee for Obedience Novice B and Rally Novice B in both Saturday trials would be \$104 (\$26 each entry). Please email the Trial Secretary if you have any questions about entries (brodee@wideopenwest.com).

Rally High Combined AdvB/ExcB and Rally Triple High Combined

A rosette and \$30.00 will be presented to the dog with the highest combined score in the Rally Triple High Combined and \$25.00 for Rally High Combined. In case of a point tie, the lowest combined time will decide the winner. In case of a tie in points and time, a run-off will be designated by the Event Committee with exhibitors performing a Rally Novice Exercise.

The following rules have been established for the good of all exhibitors concerned. Failure to comply could result in an Event Committee action (Chapter 5, Section 2 of "Rules Applying To Registration and Discipline").

1. Plastic sheeting is to be placed under every crate in hotel rooms. This will keep carpets clean and dry. Plastic sheeting for each crate will be the responsibility of each exhibitor to provide his or her own.
2. DOGS MUST BE CRATED WHEN OWNER IS OUT OF THE ROOM. NO EXCEPTIONS.
3. DOGS MUST BE KEPT ON LEASH AT ALL TIMES, WHILE IN THE HOTEL, LOBBIES, OR ON HOTEL GROUNDS. ROOMS AND LOBBY MUST BE KEPT CLEAN OF DOG DEBRIS.
4. Dogs should be "exercised" in designated areas on motel premises. Every dog owner is expected to pick up after his or her own dog and dispose waste in designated trashcans. **It is the responsibility of the dog owner to find out from the innkeeper where these areas and cans are located.**
5. No dog may be bathed in the hotel due to severe drain pipe clogging problems.
6. Rooms may be inspected daily by members of the hotel management

Receipt of entry will be sent to those providing an email address. Acknowledgment of entries will be made as soon as possible after the closing date with the Judging Program and directions to the Trial Site. Should such acknowledgment not be received by the exhibitor within a reasonable time, please contact the Trial Secretary. **Overnight or express entries MUST have waiver of signature. Failure to do so may result in your entry not being picked up in a timely manner.**

AKC Event & Recording Fees will be required for the first entry of each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking test. The fees are to be collected by the trial-giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the Fees are to be collected on the first entry only. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2). The recording and event fees are included in the entry fee.

No Entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.

Entry Fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the trial, no refund of entry fees will be made.

Post Dated and Returned Checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The trial giving Club will add a collection fee in the amount of \$25.00 for each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.

Errors on Entry Forms. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellations of entries after the published closing date.

Dogs May Arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.

Judges Will Not Wait for Any Dog Holding Up a Class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged.

All Dogs Present must be held on leash at all times when on trial grounds or confined to their crates, except when being judged. No dogs under six months of age are to be on the trial grounds

For safety reason, no flexi leashes permitted in the buildings.

Due to limited crating, no X-pens permitted.

No overnight parking or camping permitted at the site.

No gasoline or diesel generators are permitted inside of any building or within 100 feet of the show grounds on which this obedience trial is conducted. No electrical hookups will be available.

No Smoking is allowed in the building.

Neither the Trial Committee nor Columbus All Breed Training Club will be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog on the trial grounds, whether as a result of an accident or any other cause. It is clearly understood that every dog entered in the trial is in the care, custody, and control of its owner or handler, during the entire time the dog is on the trial premises.

Transfers will be approved in accord with Chapter 1, Section 16a of the Obedience Regulations, provided that a written request is submitted to the Trial Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the Trial, and that the limit has not been reached in the requested class.

Qualifying scores are required for all awards.

Because of limited space, exercise pens will not be allowed in the building or in the parking area, and crates must be stacked, if necessary, to allow room for all exhibitors and dogs.

All trophies must be claimed on the day of the Trial; none will be mailed. Any unclaimed awards become the property of the CATC.

A trophy of equal value will be substituted in the event that a specific trophy is unavailable.

A refund of all but \$5.00 of each entry fee will be made to an exhibitor with a bitch that has come into season after the close of entries or an injured dog unable to compete, providing that a statement from a veterinarian is submitted to the Trial Secretary no later than 30 minutes before the beginning of judging on the day of the Trial.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendations to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

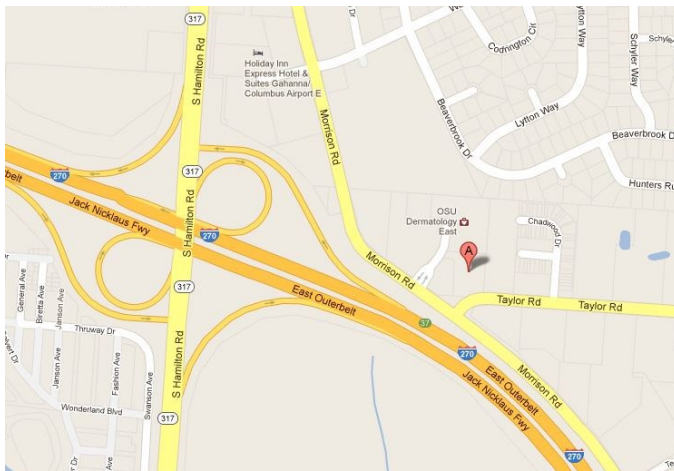

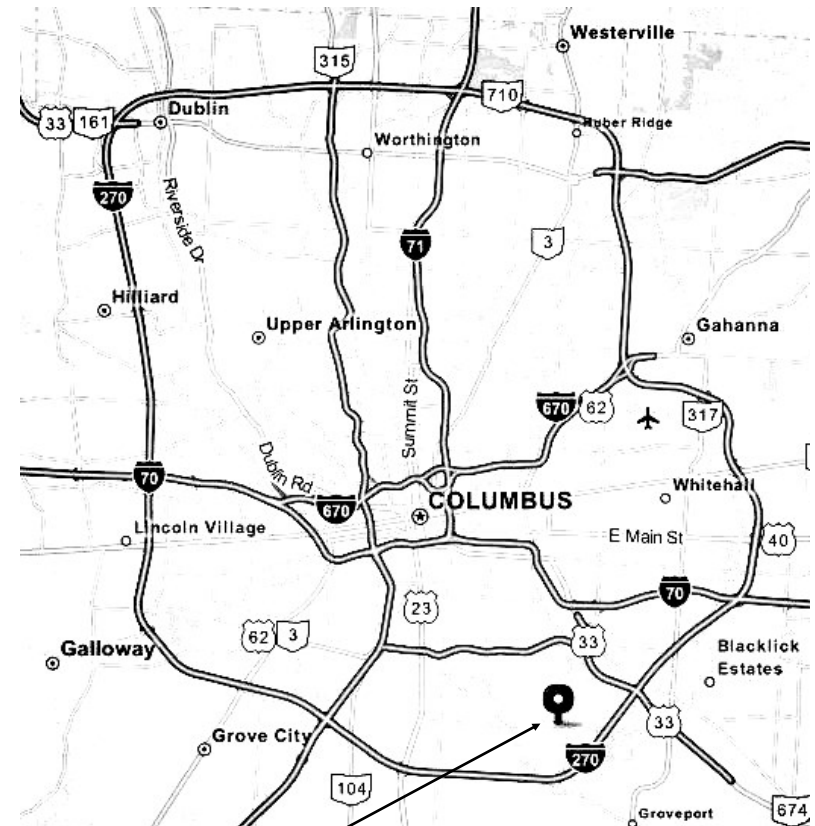

4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed.
