DESCRIPTION: The RARE Wambaw X-12 was the last entry into the Shakespeare bow line. It was introduced in 1975 and made during 75 and part of 1976 until Shakespeare decided to close its archery division that year rather than enter the compound bow market. Like other Shakespeare models, the Wambaw is a great looking and performing recurve. Factory installed stabilizer insert. Comfortable grip. This bow is accurate and fast for a vintage recurve. Bow has no delamination; no cracks; limbs are straight. Beveled arrow shelf. Overlays and tips are in great condition. 2 professionally filled screw holes on the side of the riser (see pic on last page). No chips, dings or cracks. No crazing or stress cracks; the Shakespeare logos are in original minty condition. To me, this bow seems like a 58" version of the Super Necedah X-32.

Comes with a new string and the Shakespeare rest and side plate as shown.
