This is part of an organised and controlled event, with no speeding, and appropriate stops for fuel, food and rest factored in to the event.

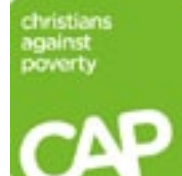

CAP NEED DEBT COACHES



Christians Against Poverty, Rugby (CAP) urgently requires at least one additional Debt Coach to work with the Centre Manager, Andrew Lewis.

CAP provides a first class, personal and holistic debt counselling service that is open to all people regardless of their faith. Applicants must be prepared to offer at least one day per week in addition to attending an initial training course and a short conference each year.

Debt Coaches do not need to be experts in budgeting, but do need to be well organised and good communicators. They must be prepared to be invited into client's homes and to be willing to share the Gospel with clients and to work with the other members of the multi-church group that currently provides the service under the Revive banner. This could be a paid or unpaid position depending on the individual's circumstances and availability.
