**ByLaws.** One of the forgotten needs of any organization and of every post is the periodic updating of its ByLaws to conform with revisions made locally and by entities that we are a part of. Our current District 29 Commander, Ken George, has made it a priority to ensure that all posts update their

ByLaws. The District 29 Commander, Ren George, has indee it a priority to ensure that an posts update their ByLaws. The District Judge Advocate, Ed Alvarez, had intended to hold a training of all District 29 Judge Advocates to <u>encourage</u> every post to review and update their ByLaws. I was scheduled to assist him in this effort. Sadly and unexpectedly, Ed passed away in late August. Cmdr. George appointed me Chair of the District 29 By laws Committee and asked me to continue the effort. At our September 14 Post Meeting, I indicated that I am putting together a program for all the District 29 Judge Advocates for October 7 at our Post.

<u>No NFL Football at Post 132</u>: At the Post 132 General Meeting on Thursday, September 14, a motion was unanimously adopted forbidding the showing of any NFL football, including the Super Bowl on and within the Post property until the NFL changes its permissive policy regarding player disrespect for the US Flag and National Anthem. I will present a similar motion to the next meeting of District 29.

<u>USA Naturalization</u>. I again remind you that if you know of any active or honorably discharged military who are NOT citizens but would like to be but haven't applied because of the ordinary \$680 filing fee, they are ENTI-TLED to file WITHOUT ANY FILING FEE. Have them contact me for more information.

**Escondido, Amador, and Santa Ana Posts.** My duties as First Vice Commander for our District 29 have given me the opportunity to visit some other Legion posts and see what they have and how they operate. If you have the opportunity, visit them! The Amador Post is in tiny Sutter Creek but is a major operation with a beautiful, modern and roomy post and museum. Santa Ana Post (on Grand Avenue across from Target) has undergone a major remodeling. They need our support. I just returned from the beautiful facility in Escondido (230 E. Park Ave., 92025) which has a great hall, a clubroom/bar setup like a nightclub, and a very large covered and uncovered patio.

<u>New Department (State) Commander</u>. Recently elected Dept. Cmdr. Art CASTRO, resigned his position because of his health. He was replaced by Robert HEINISCH, the commander of Newhall Post 507. Our Post Adjutant, Bill SILER, iii, was a nominee but lacked enough votes. Though we are sad that Bill did not win, we are ecstatic that he can remain among us at Post 132!


Hello Brothers and Sisters,


