The OWNER is strongly encouraged; therefore, to carry reasonable insurance for public liability, accidental injury, theft, mortality insurance not only for your horse but also for any personal property, tack etc. stored on property.

JHOLD HARMLESS: OWNER agrees to hold MY SERENITY FARMS harmless from any claim
$resulting \ from \ damage \ or \ injury \ caused \ by \ said \ horse \ to \ anyone \ and \ agrees \ to \ pay \ any \ legal \ fees \ and/or \ expenses \ incurred$

KINHERENT RISKS AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK: The undersigned acknowledges there are
inherent risks associated with equine activities such as described below and hereby expressly assumes all risks associated
with participating in such activities. The inherent risks include, but are not limited to the propensity of equines to behave in
ways such as, running, bucking, biting, kicking, shying, stumbling, rearing, falling or stepping on, that may result in an
injury, harm or death to persons on or around them; the unpredictability of equine's reaction to such things as sounds,
sudden movement and unfamiliar objects, persons or other animals; certain hazards such as surface and subsurface
conditions; collisions with other animals; the limited availability of emergency medical care; and the potential of a
participant to act in a negligent manner that may contribute to injury to the participant or others, such as failing to maintain
control over the animal or not acting within such participant's ability. Under Georgia law, an equine activity sponsor or
equine professional is not liable for an injury to or the death of a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent
risks of equine activities, pursuant to Chapter 12 of Title 4 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated.
LOWNERSHIP: OWNER warrants that he owns or leases said horse and that there are no liens against
said horse, express or by law. Leasees shall provide a copy of the lease agreement to MY SERENITY FARMS.

MDEFAULT: Either party may terminate this agreement for failure of other party to meet any material

ORIGHT OF LIEN: OWNER is put on notice that MY SERENITY FARMS has a right of lien, as set
forth in the law of the state of Georgia, for the amount due for the board and keep of such horse, and also for such storage
and shall have the right, without process of law, to retain the said horse and tack until the amount of such indebtedness is
discharged.
PENTIRE AGREEMENT: This contract represents the entire agreement between the parties. No other
agreements, promises, or representations, verbal or implied, are included herein unless specifically stated in this written

## BARN RULES FOR BOARDERS AND STUDENTS

#### **General Rules**

- 1. Ride at your own risk!
- 2. Wear clothing appropriate for MSF's atmosphere. Riding is considered to be a classical sport. Lessons should be ridden in boots and breeches with a conservative shirt. No undergarments should show. See management for questions.
- 3. No foul language. [For definition of foul word(s), please see management.]
- 4. No smoking outside of your own vehicle.
- 5. Clean your grooming space before leaving it. A \$5.00 penalty is billed for messes left behind.
- 6. Six is the 6 ways to keep a healthy happy barn!
  - Clean up after yourself.
  - Be aware of limited resources.
  - If you turn it on, turn it off.
  - If you open it, close it.
  - Save the drama for your mama.
  - Supervise barn visitors.

### Horse and Rider Safety & Health

- 1. Owners, riders, workers and/or students must not rely on MSF's insurance policies. Please be sure that you, your equine, and/or other parties present are properly covered.
- 2. Food and turnout changes are to be requested from owner to Deborah. NO WORKER has the authority to change your horse's routine without speaking to us first.
- 3. MSF grain is NOT to be used as treats for your horse. To avoid founder and colic, a horse's diet should not be changed by more than 1 lb. per day. How much does that bag of carrots weigh?
- 4. NO horse is to be tied to stall bars. With management's permission, please install correct cross ties or single ties in your stall.
- 5. No glass containers in grooming, bathing, or riding areas.
- 6. We required wearing an ASTM/SEI approved helmet while mounted. Not adhering to these rules may warrant expulsion from MSF.
- 7. Absolutely NO dogs. We love them, but have no canine liability insurance.

### Tack & Equipment

- 1. Horse blankets must be clearly marked with horse's name. Mean Streak markers work well on the left shoulder or use surgical tape and permanent marker on the check buckles.
- 2. Borrow equipment ONLY upon consent of the owner. Return in the same condition or replace.
- 3. Ask permission before permanently adding and/or removing hardware to a stall or locker. Georgia law says that such additions become the property of the facility. If possible, screw eyes will remain when you leave.
- 4. Only marked laundry will be washed. All wraps should roll velcro into velcro. Boots should be attached to one another. Retrieve laundry within 7 days of its completion. Otherwise, we will dispose of it.
- 5. MSF schooling or lesson saddles, girths, saddle pads, polo wraps/boots, and grooming supplies located at the front of the barn in the tack up area labeled "Lesson/Schooling Only" are useable by schooling or lesson horses' ONLY.
- 6. Boarders are to supply their own tack and grooming supplies for their personal use only.
