## Our Passion

We want to ignite the fire in Girls for science, technology, engineering, and math (STEM)! Our passion is seeing young girls ages 7-14 become excited and more confident as females and minorities to close the gender gap in STEM careers. Our passion is to give the girls of rural Central Georgia easy access to STEM programs that will foster high school graduates who will become leaders and entrepreneurs of tomorrow.

## Our Purpose

Our purpose is to empower girls to join forces with other like-minded girls to become innovators, creators, developers, chemists, or engineers in their communities and beyond. Though women in STEM jobs earn 33 percent more in salary than those in non-STEM occupations, less than 25 percent of women in the United States are in a STEM workforce. Therefore, our purpose is to inspire girls to pursue these flourishing careers and improve their academic performance in these areas.



## Our Plans

Our plan is to expose girls to STEM focused topics in a nontraditional school setting. Real I.M.P.A.C.T. is constantly enhancing our programs to better equip our girls to be more competitive on all fronts. Currently, we host camps, workshops, and field trips to continue fortifying our young minority girls in STEM. Our near future plans are to introduce an afterschool component, allowing girls the chance to evolve on a daily basis. We are determined to shape and mold STEM savvy girls in our community.

## Our Programs

### STEMtastic Saturdays

We offer this program once a month and invite girls ages 7-14 to expose and teach coding, building web pages, designing games, and cosmetic chemistry, and robotics workshops and more.

### Robotics Team

We offer after-school First Lego Robotics for girl ages 9-14. A team of ten girls are mentored for 4 hours a week beginning in September and ending in December. Girls will learn to design, build, test, and program robots using LEGO® MINDSTORMS® technology, all while applying real-world math and science concepts. Our 2015 Pretty Cool Lego Girls Team won the Middle GA Regional Innovative Solutions Award!

### Girl Power Summer STEM Camp

Summer camps are hosted weekly for multiple weeks with a primary teaching focus in science, technology, engineering and math to underrepresented minority girls, ages 7-14. In addition, we focus on character development with activities on anti-bullying, health education, and financial literacy.
