serving Westfield, Southwick, and Northern Connecticut, as well as the hilltown communities and the entire Pioneer Valley. Rabbi Efraim Eisen is the congregation's spiritual leader with services held at the Ferst Interfaith Center at Westfield State University.

Sabbath Services are held on a regular basis with dates listed in our bi-monthly newsletter. In addition, a variety of special events are planned each year beginning with High Holiday services, a community Breakthe-Fast, a Chanukah party, Purim celebration, and a Passover Seder. The congregation is also blessed with children becoming Bar and Bat Mitzvah each year. We plan additional adult and children-oriented programming throughout the year, as well as participate as a congregation in helping out at the Westfield Soup Kitchen monthly and on Christmas Day.

Our Hebrew School focuses on children who are in Grades 3 – Middle School. The curriculum focuses on the learning of Hebrew, customs, prayers and Bar/Bat Mitzvah training. It is held once per week through the school year. We also offer our popular Sunday school program for younger children. Classes are held on a monthly basis. Many of the services that are held throughout the year are geared to children and their families to strengthen the knowledge and put into practice that which is taught during the year.

We have continued to make Congregation Ahavas Achim as affordable as possible, so that those who are unable to afford congregations elsewhere can join us. Our family dues are only \$550.00 per family and \$275.00 a year for an individual membership, with no additional charges for High Holy Day services. The congregation partially subsidizes Hebrew School tuition by only charging \$300.00 per student and \$175.00 for each additional sibling. If there are enough young children to hold Sunday School, there is a small annual fee to cover expenses.

Our congregation plays a major role in giving both adults and children a sense of Jewish identity, so important in this area. In addition, our congregation is small enough so that an individual's spiritual needs can be met in a warm, supportive atmosphere. If you are looking for a friendly place to enjoy the holidays, say Yizchor for a departed one, or if you want to explore your Jewish roots, please join us. In the process, you will be helping maintain Judaism in this area. We are happy to welcome those new to Judaism, members of mixed marriages, and their children. On request, our Rabbi would be glad to talk to members about conversion, should that be your personal choice.
