KIDS AFTER SCHOOL LEISORE (GRADES K-6)

Our Kids After School Leisure Program is based on Canada's High Five® quality standard for children's recreation and sport. Our aim for this program is to provide the participants with a safe environment that promotes healthy child development, with a focus on being physically active!

Daily Activities will include:

- Zone play (imagination zone, building zone, active zone, quiet zone)
- We will spend as much time as possible outside
- Activities will focus on physical activity, fundamental movement and art

Hours of Operation: 2:30-5:30pm, Monday – Friday (we are closed for regular holidays)

Ages: 5-12 (grades K-6) **Resuming:** January 3rd, 2023 **End Date:** June 16, 2023

REGISTRATION is active on our website gouldsrecreation.com. Registration is only for the current school year (2022/2023) and will not be carried over to the following year (2023/2024). We strongly recommend you place your child's name on the wait list if you are unsuccessful in obtaining one of the spaces. One may become available in the current school year.

PAYMENT: Monthly payments are preferred. Fees will be based on a Monday-Friday (5-day school week) of \$100/week (or \$20/day) for 1 child and \$90/week (\$18/day) for the 2nd child in same household. There will be a prorated cost for weeks that contain Statutory holidays. We will still operate on PD days (2:30-5:30pm). If your child will not be attending on the PD, you do not need to pay! More info on this is provided in our After School Leisure info package! We only accept cash or e-transfer for payment. While monthly payments are preferred, we will accommodate other payment options. We do require a 2-week advance payment for days/weeks attending. A 2-week notice is also required to cancel any days/weeks in order to receive refund or transfer the funds paid to future payment. If you need to discuss alternative payment plans, please feel free to speak with Nicole by calling 745-7575.

TRANSPORTATION: We provide transportation from Goulds Elementary every school day. Transportation will not be provided from St.Kevin's Junior High.

Easter Camp

We will be having an Easter Camp this year! Our Camp is based on Canada's High Five® quality standard for children's recreation and sport. Our aim for this camp is to provide the participants with a safe environment that promotes healthy child development, with a focus on being physically active!

Daily Activities will include:

- Zone play (imagination zone, building zone, active zone, quiet zone)
- Outdoor Play
- Field Trip (Location to be determined)
- Activities will focus on physical activity, fundamental movement and art

When: April 10-14 Ages: 5-12 (grades K-6) Cost: \$115/Child; \$105 for 2nd child in same household

Hours of Operation: Early drop-off is 8am, late pick up is 5:30pm. Core program activities take place between 9:30am and 4pm.

REGISTRATION begins on January 23rd, 2023 at 12 noon. Registration will be posted on our website: gouldsrecreation.com and on our Facebook Page: Goulds Recreation. We strongly recommend you place your child's name on the wait list if you are unsuccessful in obtaining one of the spaces. One may become available as we get closer to the Easter Break.

PAYMENT/CANCELLATION: Full payment is due by March 27th. March 27th is also the last day to cancel and receive a full refund. Full refunds will not be issued past the March 27th deadline.

NEW!!! Semi Structured Active Play Program for toddlers and young children! This program is all about learning the fundamental movements of early child development! It will incorporate activities around crawling, walking, running, skipping, climbing, jumping, kicking, tumbling, balancing, throwing and catching. Our counselors will lead the group through fundamental obstacle courses/activities for 40 minutes, followed by free play for 20 minutes.

Learn to speak Minionese (the banana language) and engage in some very fun activities! There is sure to be a lot of laughing at this event!



Bubble Gym Time
