About Handwriting

Despite the growing use of technology, handwriting (or printing) remains an essential life skill and is the main form of assessment for students in the classroom!

Concerns related to handwriting are among the fastest growing areas of referral to Occupational Therapy (OT).

Children who struggle with the quality and/or speed of writing are frequently at a disadvantage in the classroom.

There are many well-documented consequences of poor handwriting in research literature including underachievement in school, lowered selfesteem and lack of confidence.

Many studies offer strong evidence that structured handwriting instruction leads to improved writing performance, an increase in academic success, and improved self-esteem.

Only a small number of children qualify to receive support from OT in the school system. Without direct intervention, many children continue to struggle.

Blooming Abilities offers intervention and support for children to help them achieve the success their families believe they can!



Printing Groups

The goal of our printing groups is to emphasize success for each child and build a sense of confidence when writing.

Children will be placed into a small group based upon current skill level after an initial screening assessment.

Each group session includes:

- Screening assessment and goal setting with parents
- FREE one-hour parent workshop for effective carry-over of skills
- Eight weeks of engaging small group instruction led by a registered OT who is Level 1 certified with Handwriting Without Tears®
- Weekly take home activity suggestions
- Post-group assessment and summary report of child's progress
