Parents Evening

Lemur Project

As you may be aware we have been chosen to work alongside Prof John Siraj-Blatchford and Lynnette Brock regarding sustainability in the early years. This has been linked to lots of different projects including bird watching on web cameras and more recently educating the children in the awareness of lemurs becoming extinct in the rain forest. On March 16th we have the BBC South East and local press coming in to film our activity on hide and seek using transmitter wristbands and VHF radio telemetry where the children put themselves into the role of hider and seeker. This sort of play is valuable because it supports the development of empathy and the ability to recognise links with the natural world. A poster in the shape of a lemur has been made up with the faces of the children from the Lions Wednesday afternoon group for you and we would appreciate it if you could advertise this poster e.g. back of your car window. It will also be circulated around the villages to promote the KCC/Aspinal Foundation funding to buy radio tracking equipment to protect the lemurs of Madagascar.

Book Bags

Please check and clear your child's book bag of all their drawings etc on a daily basis. The children take a lot of pride what they are doing and are keen that Mummy or Daddy see their work.

Recycling

As part of our Sustainability Project we are teaching the children about recycling. We would welcome any clean small cardboard boxes and comics/suitable magazines you may be throwing away as well as any unwanted material/ribbons. Thank you.

Dropping off/Collection Time

It has come to our attention that some parents are parking in the road adjacent to the Pre-School when dropping off/collecting their child. May we remind you that this is a private road and as such should not be used under any circumstances. Thank you.

Clothing and Footwear Code

Please ensure that all items of clothing including coats and shoes are named. We shall be going out into the garden every day so please ensure your child has a - jumper/coat to wear and that wellie boots should be clean and free of mud.

Communication

If your child is unable to attend their session due to sickness, holidays, etc could you please report this as soon as possible to the Pre-School by **telephone** (01892 724261) asap and not via Facebook.

If someone else has to collect your child, even if they are on our emergency contact sheet, please telephone us on the day. Alternatively if you know when you drop your child off in the morning please inform a member of staff and write who will be collecting your child either on the board (Lions Class) or book (Nursery). Please check your child's red Book Bag regularly for any communication we may be sending home. Any return correspondence needs to be handed to Shirley or a member of staff.

Collection Times

Could we please remind parents/carers that our collection times are 12 noon and 3.30 p.m. We have in the past had several occasions where a child has not been collected until 3.50 p.m. which obviously causes problems with safety/staffing issues. So please collect your child prior to collecting any older siblings from Primary School. Thank you.

Lunchboxes

Please ensure that all lunchboxes are named.

Following FSA guidelines we will remove any out of date items that we find in your child's lunchbox as failure to do so could result in the Pre-School being liable for a hefty fine.

As we have several children at Pre-School with nut allergies, please DO NOT give your child any nuts or nut based products in their lunchboxes. To prevent choking incidents please ensure that any grapes, tomatoes or soft fruit i.e. cherries are cut into quarters and that any stones have been removed. As these items can be a CHOKING HAZARD.

Dogs at Pre-School

As several of our children are frightened of dogs in close proximity, could you please consider leaving your dog at home/in the car when dropping off/collecting your child. Thank you
