Those of us in La Honda Indivisible who organized this event submitted questions that we hope our representatives will address, including what are they doing to end roadside broadcast spraying by Caltrans in San Mateo County and to have better response from this public agency that ignores our concerns. Our elected officials CAN end this broadcast spraying, as they have in other California areas. WE did end it on our SMC county roads and parks in 2012, so it is time to end it on our state roads NOW.

Caltrans recently sprayed "80% of Hwy. 280" again in Sept. which I photographed, emailed to reporters, and to Caltrans for confirmation which they gave on Oct. 2nd.

When I asked about current plans to spray Hwys. 84, 35 and 1:

"Caltrans has plans to spray along these routes but has not defined the timetable or the exact areas to be sprayed." *
