## Merry Christmas

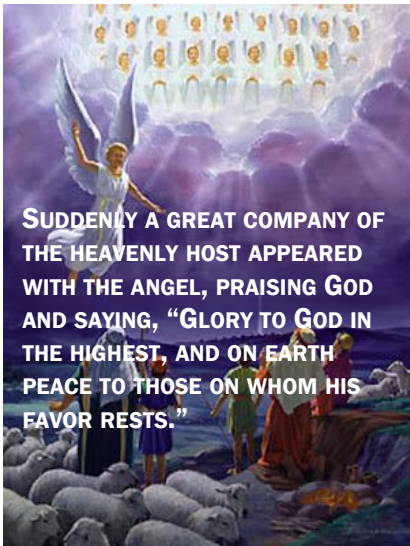
