Topics that will be covered include:

- Holistic approach to OSINT alongside LES databases (such as LinX, Accurant, TLO, CLEAR) and HUMINT
- Strategies for OSINT at scale, real-time or as assigned to an ICS Intel Section
- Deploying contact exploitation devices to rapidly exploit phone numbers and email addresses
- How to attack criminal networks by analyzing friends/followers/connections
- Analyzing geolocation, image verification and vetting online content
- Search warrants, analyzing business records, hashing, documenting searches, court preparation
- Intelligence Reporting
- Establishing OPSEC for safer investigations
- Digital manhunts
- Establishing a social media policy for investigations
- Hands-on searching of social media platforms
