Ordinance O-2014-29

**AN ORDINANCE BY THE COUNCIL OF AMELIA VILLAGE, OHIO APPOINTING
BRIAN DEEL TO THE POSITION OF PROBATIONARY FULL-TIME PUBLIC WORKS
TECHNICIAN FOR AMELIA, OHIO AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, a vacancy has occurred in the Public Works Department of Amelia Village for a full-time public works technician; and,

WHEREAS, the Mayor has recommended the appointment Brian Deel to the fill the full-time public works technician position, on a probationary basis.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by Council of Amelia Village, Clermont County, Ohio that:

SECTION I. The Mayor desires to appoint Brian Deel to the position of full-time public works technician on a probationary basis for Amelia Village, Ohio effective June 30, 2014. This appointment is contingent on the appointee passing a pre-employment physical and drug screening prior to beginning employment.

SECTION II. This position requires the employee to be CDL Class B certified prior to employment or be able to become certified within six months of employment and to maintain this CDL Class B certification during employment. Failure to meet and maintain this condition of employment may mean possible termination.

SECTION III. Council hereby confirms the appointment of Brian Deel to the position of full-time public works technician on a six month probationary basis, effective June 24, 2014.

SECTION IV. Brian Deel will begin employment at the hourly rate of fifteen dollars per hour (\$15.00) during said probationary period because he already obtained a Class B CDL license.

SECTION V. Scheduling work of said full-time employee shall be at the direction of the Mayor. Said full-time employee shall normally work forty (40) hours per week, unless the Mayor directs additional hours by emergency or necessity.

SECTION VI. Brian Deel shall be employed as an at will employee of the Village subject to all applicable rules and regulations contained in the Amelia Village Employee Manual as amended from time to time, and other such rules and regulations as the Village Council may determine from time to time are in the best interest of Amelia Village.

SECTION VII. Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of its committees, if any, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Revised Code.

SECTION VII. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of the Village, and for the further reason that it is necessary to approve this at the earliest possible time, in order to enable the Village to fulfill its statutory obligations to maintain its public streets and grounds. Therefore, provided this emergency clause receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be

in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

MR. CAMPBELL moved to suspend the rules requiring three readings on three separate dates;

MRS. GERBER seconded the motion.
