Lloyd Eargle asked how to play a lost ball.

If NOT OB, take a stroke, drop a ball and play. This is regardless to where lost. This includes the 'Leaf Rule'. It is still a lost ball.

If the ball is OB, take a stroke and hit a second ball from the same location.
