Puzzled 12 inch block
need:
A - (8) squares, $37 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 37 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ (Background fabric)
$B$ - (6) squares, $37 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 37 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ (DARK)
C - (2) squares, 3 7/8" x 3 7/8" (DARK \#2)

Puzzled 12" block

1. Cut out all squares (16) total.
2. Draw a diagonal line on each of the background fabrics.
3. Place a background fabric on top of each of the dark fabrics - right sides together.
4. Stitch $1 / 4$ " away on both sides of the diagonal line.
5. Cut on diagonal line and press to the dark...yes, some you will need to press to the background but lay the blocks out first.
6. Stitch together in rows and then columns.

Remember that you are to make this quilt your own, so have fun with the colors. If you want to make sure you have enough fabric, I recommend 4 fabrics for the focus blocks and you will need a total of 3 yards. As you can see, this block took $20^{\prime \prime} \times 20^{\prime \prime}$ and you have $4^{\prime \prime} \times 16^{\prime \prime}$ left over. Okay, I am calculating on one color and you are using 3 for this block but I hope you get my point that it is not a lot of fabric.
