- Rosemary presented the monthly budget for KACB
- Motion was made to approve last three meetings-minutes and approved. July11 August 8, Sept 12, 2016

### **New Business**

- Motion to accept Malcolm Dieckow, Rebecca Peres, Johnny Taylor and Susan Pelczar as Board Members and appointing Rebecca Peres as President was passed.
- Possible rewording of some of the positions such as IT Director to possible IT Support etc. was brought up and to be reviewed in the near future, Neli mentioned that KACB does not have Directorships currently.
- Mark expressed concern about not having any Liability Insurance. Several Board members agreed that this
  concern needs to be addressed which requires major fund raising. Aprox \$ 1800.00 is needed to obtain a
  years worth of insurance.. Mark did get a quote for \$ 400.00 for a one day event. Neither option is viable
  at this time.
- Mark said he would make some calls regarding the insurance quote
- Discussion about the next Clean up date has been put on hold until the insurance issue can be resolved.
- Discussion about Neli holding some Education classes for the Boy and Girl Scouts. The BEC Room can accommodate a max of 70 people at one time.
- A contact person with Walmart is needed to know if we can have table to hold membership drive.
- Mark and Malcolm will work on some additional fund raising options
- Neli did wrap up & review September 24, 2016 Cleanup 1330 lbs of trash collected 34 Adults and 44 young adults/Youth
- A huge Thank you to Vickie Merchant for getting the clean-up on the front page of the Rockport Pilot.
- Women's Wonderful Network also shared information about the clean-up which is greatly appreciated.
- Neli also did a slide presentation on the basic clean-up requirements from Keep Texas Beautiful. How knowing what Clean-ups are planned ahead of time allows for good planning for supplies and publicity.

- Neli also said that it is free to have a booth and maybe even a float at Tropical Christmas.
