The First Airport Shuttle Bus

The "Fordson" – 1931 Model A Ford Bus

One of the highlights for me during our tour of the Mid-America



Flight Museum was getting a close look at the 1931 Model A Ford Bus. This six-rowed, 12-18 passenger bus, was purposely built exclusively to transport Henry Ford's guests and business associates as they arrived in Ford Trimotor aircraft at the Dearborn Airfield, to the Dearborn


Inn, and then to and from the Ford manufacturing plant. The specimen in the museum is reportedly the last remaining of the six buses of this type built.

Set on a lengthened Model AA truck chassis, the bus uses a regular Model A Ford engine but has a 5-speed transmission. The body was designed by the Lang Body Company, a coach builder out of Cleveland, Ohio. It has an enlarged radiator with a special shell stamped "Fordson," a name generally used on Ford-built tractors. An odd feature of the Ford Bus is that the windshield is built in front of the gas filler cap, so refueling is done inside the vehicle. The bus has no windshield wiper, but that didn't matter... there was no air travel when it rained so there was no need for one anyway





(yeah, right). It has six independent doors on the left side, one for the driver and front row, and a door each for the other rows.



the Golden Wings Museum in Blaine, MN. Through a turn of events, the bus was then obtained by the Mid America Flight Museum owner Scott Glover sometime around 2021.

Mr. Glover then arranged to have the bus restored. During the restoration process, he was faced with the question of whether to restore the bus to its original form, or to retain a look of daily use. He compromised, and while he did have the bus restored from the ground up, the character and patina were preserved on the body.
