Discussion of new medic vehicle and recommended motion to approve
 Chief Hein discussed that the 2016 chassis may not be available much longer and the
 2017 chassis has not been built yet. If unable to locate a 2016 chassis, the pricing
 would increase and the build-out time would be longer.

Trustee Shirey discussed that we probably need to do something that the medic vehicles have lots of daily use and can't afford it to break down.

Trustee Strussion stated that the trustees have taken their time and due diligence in reviewing the need for the purchase and that it is warranted.

Trustee Shirey made motion to approve the purchase of the new medic for an estimated cost of \$228,717. Trustee Strussion seconded. All voted yes.

2. BWC Safety Grant – Stryker Cot Requisition Grant funding has been received and appropriated. The purchase requisition is being brought forward for signatures. This is one of the numerous steps in documenting the grant process and required paperwork. We have 90 days from date of funding received to purchase and implement the intervention equipment. Funding was received on March 1<sup>st</sup>.
