## ABOUT OUR GINS

### Bathtub Gin (England) 43.3%

Fresh bold juniper leads the way with fragrant **citrus, cloves, coriander** and **cardamom**.

### Copperhead (Belgium) 40%

Comprised of 5 botanicals – **juniper, coriander, cardamom, orange peel** and **angelica**. The balance is absolutely perfect.

### Da Mhile Organic Gin (Wales) 42%

This unique small batch gin has been infused with **seaweed**. It is rich, yet light and the perfect accompaniment to seafood. The heady mix of **20 organic herbs** is the first striking element of this gin, fresh bursts of **lemon** and **thyme** combine with **fennel, peppers** and **cardamom**.

### Drumshanbo Gunpowder Gin (Ireland) 43%

An Irish Gin made with Juniper, **Angelica, Orris, Caraway, Coriander, Meadowsweet, Cardamom** and **Star Anise**, as well as vapour infused oriental **Lemon and Lime, fresh Grapefruit** and **Gunpowder Tea!**

### Fifty Pound Gin (England) 43.5%

**Lemon, lime** and **junipers** are very classic in character with a slight sweetness and a touch of creamy lemon. Dry and clean finish.

In 1736 King George II introduced the 1736 Gin Act, whereby an annual levy of £50 was imposed on those wishing to produce and sell gin.

### Filliers Dry 28 (Belgium) 46%

Originally created in 1928 this small batch gin uses 28 botanicals in addition to juniper. Nose ; lemon and orange peel with a hint of cardamom and fresh coriander. Palate citrus and slightly creamy with a warm dry finish.

### Four Pillars Rare Dry Gin (Australia) 41.8%

Nose, light and sweet, Palate warm **cinnamon** and spicy **mild pepper** and a dry lemon zest finish. Small distillery in the Yarra Valley in country Victoria, they use local botanicals including, Tasmanian **pepperberry** and **lemon myrtle** combined with **cinnamon, cardamom, coriander** seeds and **star anise** as well as **juniper, lavender** and **angelica root**.

### Half Hitched Small batch hand crafted (London Camden Lock) 40%

On the nose you will discover aromatic notes of light citrus, followed by spicy, fresh **black pepper** and **juniper** berry. On the palate, tones of **sweet orange, nutmeg** and rich **black tea** before a long finish with lingering touches of **cinnamon** and **fresh lemon zest**.

## **Herno old tom Gin 43%**

Winner of the World Gin awards 2017 in the contemporary category. Rich juniper and gentle perfume aromas in a creamy soft style . Succulent rich and smooth texture. Good **juniper** depth. Exceedingly well balanced. Delicate and finely balanced with a long finish.

## **JINZU 41.3% (Scotland)**

Jinzu Gin brings English and Japanese traditions together to create an exciting, intriguing spirit. It's made with a blend of English gin( featuring **juniper, coriander, angelica, yuzu and Japanese cherry blossom** as botanicals) and **sake**, which brings a luxurious, creamy mouth feel and a subtle, compelling sweetness to its flavour profile.

## **Junipero Gin 49.3% (San Francisco) USA**

Junipero Gin is flavoured with more than a dozen botanicals by redistilling neutral spirit in a small copper pot still. The Junipero carries a rich fruity palate, with citrus interaction followed by **juniper, coriander and liquorice** freshness, rooty hints, and a burst of citrus zest in the finish.

## **Kintyre Gin 43% (Scotland)**

From the Torrisdale castle estate, this new gin has an earthy and spicy characteristic, being deep in flavour with a floral aroma . Including botanicals such as, **lemon peel, Icelandic moss, almonds, orris root and sheep sorrel**.

## **Kirkjuvagr Orkney Gin 43% (Scotland)**

An unmistakably Orcadian gin made with locally grown botanicals including **Ramanas Rose, Burnet Rose, Angelica** and **Borage**. The inclusion of Angelica was inspired by a story that suggested Angelica was brought to the Orkney Island by the Norsemen.

## **Langtons No.1 Lakeland Gin (Cumbria) 40%**

Fresh citrus characters dominate with a light touch of sweetness followed by a smooth finish. A celebration of the Lake District, Langtons use **local ingredients** amongst their **11 botanicals**. Slate-filtered water is extracted via a borehole under the Skiddaw Mountain near Keswick.

## **Lone Wolf 44%**

Made by Brew Dog, recently launched this crafted gin features a selection of botanicals, including **Thai lemongrass, Kaffir lime leaf, coriander, pink peppercorns and red grapefruit peel**.

## **Monkey 47 Schwarzald Dry Gin (Germany) 47%**

Distinct scents of **citrus** and **lavender** notes accompany the botanical sweet aroma. A distinct and pure scent of **juniper**, with a hint of peppery spices and a subtle bitter fruit of **cranberries** leaves a deep and harmonious balanced complexity.

## **Pickering 42% (Scotland)**

Pickering's Gin is distilled in Edinburgh using a recipe found on a piece of paper which was written in 1947. After finely-tuning the ingredients, featuring botanicals like **Juniper, Lemon, Lime, Coriander, Anise, Angelica, Cardamom, Clove and Fennel**, the folks at the Summerhall distillery started putting together their refreshing gin using a 500-litre copper still, charmingly named Gert.

## **Slingsby 42% (Harrogate)**

London Dry style, launched in August 2015, using 24 botanicals this gin has notes of **jasmine** and celery on the nose. The palate is more classical with **juniper, orris root** and a hint of **liquorice** and the finish is a touch sweeter with **rosewater and fresh sage**.

## **Spirit of Hven Organic Gin (Sweden) 40%**

Hand crafted organic gin from the island of Hven. Depth of flavour with warming **Sichuan pepper**, and **anise**. The oak maturation gives this an oily and smooth mouthful and smooth finish.

Fact: The only gin served at Copenhagen's Noma
