### **REYKJAVIK GRAND EXCURSION TOUR (3 HOURS)**

A great introduction to Iceland starts with a city tour of its capital, Reykjavik, the northernmost in the world! ### **THE NORTHERN LIGHTS NIGHTTIME CRUISE (2 HOURS)**

The Northern Lights (Aurora Borealis) are a natural light display in the sky, caused by electrically charged particles from the sun colliding with gaseous particles in the Earth's atmosphere.

The Northern Lights are most frequently seen around the North Pole, within an oval-shaped region drawn around the Northern hemisphere called the “auroral oval”. Iceland lies within this most active region, meaning that the Northern Lights are potentially visible from everywhere in Iceland.

You will depart from Reykjavik Harbor, sailing out to see the aurora borealis under the dark night of the North Atlantic Ocean with the beautiful mountains and the glow of the night skyline in the background. On your way out, your tour guide will provide background on the natural phenomena, its surrounding folklore and superstition, as well as explaining the underlying scientific facts that make this magical light show possible. The tour boat is ideally designed for sightseeing cruises, with excellent viewing areas on the outside decks, and a warm and cozy seating area inside if you get too cold.

### **GOLDEN CIRCLE TOUR (8 HOURS)**

Discover Iceland's most iconic natural and historical attractions on this tour.

Capture the essence of Iceland with this classic tour covering the essential Golden Circle of Iceland. You'll visit historic Thingvellir, a landmark and the most popular national park in the country where Iceland's national identity was forged thousands of years ago by peaceful Vikings. See the Queen of Waterfalls, the majestic, dual-folding Gullfoss, and, it goes without saying, an unbeatable picture-taking opportunity. At the Geysir hot springs area, marvel at Strokkur geyser which spouts steam every few minutes with amazing force.
