PEANUT BUTTER FOR HAITI



We have started the annual Peanut Butter Drive. Please drop your peanut butter off at the Mission Center. Here are some "Sticky Stats" about your peanut butter donations.....

- ◆ 500 toddlers receive a weekly supply of peanut butter. Raisins, canned meats and/or other nutritious foods high in iron and protein are given when available.
- ◆ 50+ infants (old enough to eat it) receive peanut butter each week.
- ◆ 75 jars are given to the Lifeline Children's Home each month.
- ◆ During disasters, thousands of jars of peanut butter are given out through Lifeline's Disaster Relief Program.
- ◆ 250+ families receive peanut butter each week in the Family Nutrition Programs.
- ◆ Several hundred jars are given out quarterly to very needy children in the schools.
- ◆ Lifeline shares peanut butter with many other missions in Haiti.

Annually, the Permanent Endowment Committee makes available those funds obtained from income received from their investments. The application process is now open. Applications may be picked up in the office and are due back into the office by June 1. Awards will be funded no later than June 1, 2020.

\$1,670.16 of this balance is funds designated for flowers, Library, building use, etc. This leaves an operating balance of **\$18,810.16** with which to begin the budget year 2020. We were able to fully pay all salaries and invoices for year end. However, we were not able to pay 100% of our Conference and District Apportionments. We paid half of the District and a little less than half of the Conference. I will continue to keep a close watch on the finances and pay salaries and invoices as funds are available. Utilities will be paid first, then salaries, then others as we are able. We also must continue to keep a close watch on any unnecessary spending.
