Rules and Tournament Notes:

- 1. Good sportsmanship is demanded of all players, coaches and fans. Unsportsmanlike conduct will not be tolerated, and could result in forfeit of a game or games. Inappropriate behavior will result in dismissal. The purpose of this tournament is to provide a positive experience for our youth.
- 2. Iowa High School Rules will apply, with the following exceptions. Games will start every 50 minutes, meaning pregame warm up times may be limited. Games will consist of two seventeen (17) minute halves with a continuous clock. Halftime will be four (4) minutes. The clock will stop on dead balls in the last minute of the game. Overtime will be one (1) minute. If still tied after the first overtime, the second overtime will be sudden victory.
- 3. Three (3) time outs per game. One (1) time out in overtime. Unused time outs do not carry over into overtime.
- 4. No full court press or zone defense for the 4th and 5th grade level until the final two minutes of the game.
- 5. No full court press after a team reaches a 20-point lead. (6th,7th, and 8th)
- 6. No three point goals in the 4th and 5th Grade Age Brackets. Three point goals will count in the 6th, 7th and 8th Grade Age Brackets.
- 7. All technical fouls are an automatic two points plus possession of the ball. No free throws will be shot.
- All rosters are final at the start of your first game. Any team that is not ready to play five (5) minutes after their scheduled game time will forfeit the game. Five (5) players must be on the floor to start the game.
- 9. Home Team will be the team listed first on the schedule. Home team will wear white and the visitor will wear dark jerseys. If this does not work the two head coaches simply come to an agreement and inform the officials and scorekeepers of any changes.
- 10. Only the teams who are playing will be allowed to shoot during pre-game warmups and halftimes. Players will not be allowed to shoot baskets during timeouts when their team is not involved in a game. This will reduce disruption and eliminate problems related to loose basketballs during timeouts.
- 11. Marion Independent School District assumes no responsibility for injuries to participants or theft of personal possessions during the tournament. Coaches are responsible for their players' conduct on and off the court.
- 12. Bring your own warm up balls. Game balls will be provided.
- 13. **Very Important:** Please inform your players and families that there is no dribbling or passing the basketball in the cafeteria area, hallways, or in either gym when a game is in progress. There are many glass trophy cases surrounding the cafeteria. We want to avoid any damage or injury.

Tiebreakers (if pool play is used): The following criteria will be used if two or more teams have identical won-loss records after pool play. 1) won-loss record, 2) head to head, 3) total points allowed, 4) point differential for each pool game played, 5) coin flip.
