Discussion of affordable housing – Fremont Woodward Fremont and Lance discussed impact fees for the Cinema Court project with the board. Several options were presented that could potentially reduce the per-unit cost to the development. President Pyatt tentatively appointed Gary, Lance, and Preston to a committee that will investigate these options and report back to the board.

Discussion of proposed accessory dwelling ordinance – Krissie Killoy Grand County Krissie Killoy and Mary Hofhine of Grand County Community Development discussed the proposed accessory dwelling ordinance with the board. The proposed ordinance allows the accessory dwelling to be detached from the principal dwelling, however, the property will have a deed restriction to prevent subdivision. Uses of the dwelling were discussed as well as enforcement of the proposed ordinance. The committee will also consider options for impact fees for accessory uses.

Lake/Snow Report The lake has 632.5 AF in storage. The Beeman pump is running.
