

Pastor's Paragraphs

One of the joys I've had as an interim pastor is exploring new areas of western PA. For 9½ years I worked in Churchill and got to know the eastern suburbs of Pittsburgh fairly well. I spent 15 months in the south hills (Bethel Park) and 3 years in Moon Twp. (by the airport) and I've visited various hospitals all over the Pittsburgh region and been here in Lower Burrell for a few months. However, I still find it a challenge to get "there" from "here." Just last week I went through a part of Plum (the township where I live) that I had never seen before. There is no such thing as a straight road in this area. Trying to navigate can be a nightmare, or a fun adventure, depending on one's perspective and how much time you have. Thank God for GPS.

Before I head out to drive somewhere I often open up Google Maps and see where I'm going. The GPS on my phone is even handier because it goes with me. It's not perfect and sometimes doesn't work, but it works much better than directions that some people give:

- "Turn right at the corner with the big oak tree. (How many oak trees are there in Pittsburgh?) Go a couple of blocks and veer left where the old BP gas station used to be" (Used to be?)
- "Ya go down this road for a couple miles or so, and then turn at the barn that doesn't have a roof on it. My house is the third driveway on the right. We have a green mailbox out front." (The mailbox was probably painted green 20+ years ago, or fallen down, or covered by bushes)

In spite of my GPS there are still times when I find myself driving around looking for a place. The lack of street signs doesn't help either.

Sometimes the Christian life is like trying to navigate through Pittsburgh. Yet God has not left us without help, but has given us the Holy Spirit. Thankfully, the Holy Spirit is *not* like Google Maps. Though we know our ultimate destiny (heaven) we aren't given all the details of how we are going to get there. At best, we are usually given the next step or two. Rather than simply giving us directions that we have to follow, the Holy Spirit goes with us, to guide on our way. Rather than a map, we are given a companion for the journey.

The greatest part of God's way of leading us is that even when we make a wrong turn, even when we are on the wrong road, we are not alone, for the Holy Spirit is with us, and God owns all the roads. "All the paths of the Lord are steadfast love and faithfulness." (Psalm 25:10)

Join us, for worship on May 20 as we celebrate Pentecost and the work of the Holy Spirit in our lives.

Maria volunteered to order 80 bookmarks to be handed out on Mother's Day. Mick will look for something for Father's Day.

The duties for the 2018-2019 year were passed around for deacons to decide what special jobs they would like to handle for the year.

The ushering schedules for the May 2018 – April 2019 year were passed out to the deacons who will be serving.

Two sign-up sheets were sent around for a commitment to attend a Session meeting and if any deacon was willing to go with Doug on a communion visit to our shut-ins.

We voted to have Sandra increase the Large Print "Our Daily Bread" from 60 to 70 copies.

Sandra reported there are 9 students who will receive Walmart gift cards to encourage them during finals.

The meeting closed with Denise leading the prayer time.

The next scheduled meeting will be Wednesday May 2, 2018 at 6:30pm. It will be partly a dessert social time to welcome new deacons and thank the deacons retiring from active service.


