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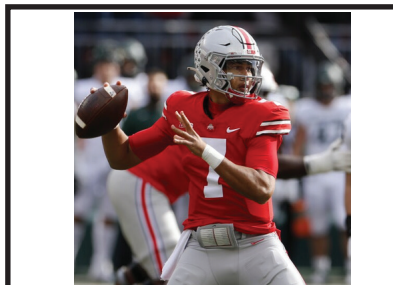

No. 4 Ohio St crushed No. 7 Michigan St 56-7 last Saturday as 19.5-point favorites. Buckeye QB CJ Stroud threw 6 TD passes in the first half and is now the Heisman front-runner! We bet Stroud to win the Heisman back in June at 40/1.

ATS Notables

Notre Dame was +37 ATS points vs Georgia Tech in a 55-0 win (-18). The Colorado St/Hawaii game went OVER the total by 41.5 points! The Kent St/Akron game went UNDER the total by 35.5 points! Michigan (+8.5 ppg) and Oklahoma St (+7.9) are both 9-2 ATS this year. New Mexico is 1-10 ATS this year failing to cover by an average of 6.7 ppg! The OVER is 8-3 in Pitt games going OVER by an average of 8.9 ppg! The UNDER is 9-2 in Penn St games going UNDER by an average of 9.5 ppg!

Misleading Finals

UL-Lafayette beat Liberty 42-14. However, ULL only had a 296-293 yard edge but were +6 in TO's.

Colorado upset Washington 20-17 However, Misleading Washington had a 426-183 yard edge but were -4 in TO's. Colorado's Jack Lamb returned a fumble 88 yards for a touchdown. Before the fumble, Washington was 31 for 31 this season in trips inside the red zone.

Old Dominion beat Middle Tennessee 24-17. However, MT had 25-11 first down and 414-341 yard edges but were -2 in TO's.

Oklahoma beat Iowa St 28-21. However, Iowa St had a 361-305 yard edge but were -2 in TO's. Late in the second quarter, Iowa State drove into Oklahoma territory. Oklahoma's Key Lawrence jarred the ball loose from Purdy, and Redmond got

the perfect bounce in stride and took it 42 yards for a touchdown. The score gave the Sooners a 14-7 lead with nine seconds left in the first half.

UTSA beat UAB 34-31. However, UAB had a 474-375 yard edge including 220-52 on the ground. UTSA QB Frank Harris scooped up a low snap and threw a 1-yard touchdown pass to Oscar Cardenas with three seconds left. Trailing much of the game, the Roadrunners got the ball back with 1:09 left after stuffing the Blazers a yard short of a first down on third-and-4 at the UAB 42. Inches short of a first down, Blazers coach Bill Clark opted to punt the ball prior to his team drawing a delay-of-game penalty to make it fourth-and-6.

Georgia St beat Arkansas St 28-20. However, Georgia St had a 434-270 yard edge including 282-(-3) on the ground. Arkansas St got a 80-yard fumble return TD with 4:22 left in the 4Q.

Injuries/Personnel News

Baylor QB Gerry Bohanon (hamstring) is questionable for this week's game. Buffalo QB Kyle Vantrese (arm) is out for the season. Iowa St QB Brock Purdy (concussion) is questionable for this week's game vs TCU. Kansas St QB Skylar Thompson is doubtful for this week's game vs Texas. Nebraska QB Adrian Martinez (shoulder) is out of this week's game vs Iowa. North Carolina QB Sam Howell (upper body) is probable vs NC State. Oregon WR's Johnny Johnson and Jaylon Redd are out for the season. UNLV QB Cameron Friel (foot) is questionable vs Air Force.

Dan Mullen was fired as the Gators' football coach on Sunday. Mullen was given the opportunity to coach the regular-season finale against Florida State on Saturday, according to AD Stricklin, but turned it down, saying he didn't want to be a distraction. Assistant coach Greg Knox was named interim head coach. Mullen was 34-15 in four seasons at Florida.

Troy fired head coach Chip Lindsey. Defensive coordinator Brandon Hall was named interim head coach. Lindsey went 15-19 in his three seasons at Troy.

UMass has hired Arizona defensive coordinator Don Brown as its next coach. Brown, in his first season at Arizona, is expected to coach in the Wildcats' season finale Saturday at Arizona State before transitioning into his new role. Brown, 66, is set to begin his second stint as UMass coach. He went 43-19 from 2004 to 2008 -- the winningest five-year period in team history -- while UMass competed in the FCS. Brown also served as head coach at Northeastern and Plymouth State. The Spencer, Massachusetts, native was UMass' defensive coordinator in 1998 and 1999.

Recapping Week 12 Best Bets

We went 3-2 in the colleges with both of our top plays winning again. That's a 15-1 run on those 3★'s. The NFL went 2-2 but our top play on Houston was an outright winner as a double-digit underdog.

Games in Rotation Order

HOME TEAM IN CAPS

Thursday, November 25th

Mississippi St 31 OLE MISS 30. With all due respect to the NFL, we look forward to this game the most on Thursday. It's one of the more important Egg Bowls in recent memory. Mississippi St was a 44-point favorite vs Tennessee St last week. Head coach Mike Leach decided to kick a 43-yard FG with :27 left to win 55-10. That's 5 straight covers for the Bulldogs. Most people when they think of Ole Miss, they think high scoring and a high-powered offense. The reality is Ole Miss games have gone UNDER the total in 6 straight by an average of 20.7 points per game!

Fresno St 30 SAN JOSE ST 23. Fresno St needs a win to stay in the hunt for a Mountain West division championship. Meanwhile, San Jose needs a win for bowl eligibility. The UNDER has cashed in 4 straight in the series and we did bet UNDER 57.5 on the Sunday openers. However, we wouldn't bet it now at the current numbers.

Friday, November 26th

Ohio 29 BOWLING GREEN 23. Two losing teams just playing out the season here. Ohio has been in better form as of late with wins in 2 of their last 3 games while BG has been blown out in their last two. As long as wind isn't an issue (it can be at the Doyt), we like the OVER here (bet OVER 46 on the openers and still like it).

2★ EMU (plus the points) CENTRAL MICHIGAN 34 Eastern Michigan 28. This one is for bowl positioning with NIU already having locked up the MAC West. The Eagles are in their preferred away underdog role with a 20-4 ATS current run! CMU is playing well but we can't lay more than a TD in a rivalry game. We bet Eastern Michigan +9 on the Sunday openers.

Boise St 23 SAN DIEGO ST 20. 9am local kick for this one to get the national CBS audience. San Diego St needs a win to clinch the West division in the Mountain West. However, we think Boise St is the best team in the conference currently (see blowout win at Fresno St a few weeks ago). The Broncos played a tough schedule early and have settled in nicely under first-year coach Andy Avalos. We lean Broncos and totals players note the UNDER is 8-2-1 in Boise games this year including 6 straight.

TEXAS 27 Kansas St 24. Texas is in their worst stretch of football since 1956. They have lost 6 straight games and failed to cover 6 straight by 12.3 ppg. If you're surprised they are favored here, don't be. It looks like Kansas St will be playing without QB Skylar Thompson. He's worth at least 3 points to the spread, if not more. We bet UNDER 53.5 on the openers.

Utah St 32 NEW MEXICO 16. Utah St needs a win and a Boise St loss to win the Mountain division. They got their teeth kicked down their throats last week in a blowout loss to Wyoming at home. On the other side, New Mexico is the worst team in the country ATS wise this year at 1-10! New Mexico finished last week's game with Bryson Carroll—who was a student team manager just three weeks ago—at quarterback after an injury knocked out starter Isaiah Chavez. "Obviously, offensively we're kind of a joke right now," New Mexico coach Danny Gonzales said. We bet UNDER 52.5 on the open as it is 8-3 in New Mexico games this season by an average of 9.1 ppg.

Iowa 21 NEBRASKA 20. Nebraska might go down as the greatest 3-win team in CFB history. We had to downgrade them 3.5-points though for the loss of QB Adrian Martinez who will not play in this game. Redshirt Freshman Logan Smothers will get the start. Otherwise, a 3-8 Nebraska team would have been favored over a 9-2 Iowa team. The Huskers, when healthy, are a Top 25 caliber team as they are No. 21 in ypp margin (Iowa No. 75). All 8 of Nebraska's losses this year have come by single-digits. They've lost 6 straight vs Iowa. We would've picked them to win had Martinez played but Smothers is an unknown. He is 6-2 195 and a 4-star dual threat QB from Muscle Shoals, Alabama.

UAB 32 Utep 17. This one is for bowl positioning. UAB lost a heart-breaker to UTSA last week which would have given them a great shot at another division title. Inches short of a first down, Blazers coach Bill Clark opted to punt the ball prior to his team drawing a delay-of-game penalty to make it fourth-and-6. "Lord, I wanted to go for it," Bill Clark said. "I just didn't know how to live with myself, giving them the ball, if we just somehow, something happened. The ball went through his hands (or) he slipped. I mean, I've done that before. Maybe probably not that far back. With one minute left, I mean making them go 70-80 yards, I just, I'd do that 100 out of 100 times." It was the wrong decision coach! With that said, our numbers lean UAB here.

NC STATE 33 North Carolina 28. Sam Howell should play here for North Carolina after missing last week's game vs Wofford. It could be his final game depending on whether or not he opts out of the bowl game and starts getting ready for the NFL Draft. North Carolina has dominated the last two seasons but NC State is the better team statistically this year as they are No. 18 in ypp margin while North Carolina is No. 39. Slight lean on the UNDER.

ARKANSAS 39 Missouri 22. We were super impressed with Arkansas' effort last week at Alabama in a 7-point loss. "We matched the physicality of what Alabama's known for," Pittman said. "I just told (the players) the days of getting our teeth kicked in are over. I think we proved that at least for this week." On the other side, Missouri is bowl eligible after their OT upset over Florida. However, we feel they are out-classed here.

UCF 38 South Florida 22. We were surprised with all the UCF money as this one opened UCF -14 on the Sunday openers. We faded the move and bet USF +19. Maybe they were fading USF off their worst performance of the season getting blown out by a 1-win Tulane team while UCF hammered UConn. Our numbers are strong on USF here (see page 7).

Coastal Carolina 36 SOUTH ALABAMA 21. Coastal Carolina QB Grayson McCall returned last week and the Chanticleers got back on track. They are still No. 3 in the country in ypp margin this year (+2.6 yards per play). Meanwhile, South Alabama was crushed by Tennessee last week. At 5-6, they're playing for bowl eligibility. They won't get it.

AIR FORCE 34 UNlv 17. The Rebels only won 2 games this season but they played one of the toughest schedules among Group of 5 teams. They are 7-3-1 ATS and 6 of their losses were by 8 points or less. Last week, UNLV lost starting QB Cam Friel midway through the first half and turned to Justin Rogers, the original starter at the beginning of the season. Rogers looked nothing like the shaky quarterback who stepped in at times. Rogers finished 15 of 21 for 305 yards and two touchdown passes vs a tough San Diego St defense. Meanwhile, Air Force still has a shot at the Mountain division title. We would have the slightest of leans on UNLV here.

IOWA ST 37 Tcu 21. It was an incredibly disappointing season for Iowa St at 6-5. Last week they were better than OU in the stats but a couple of key turnovers did them in. They're playing a TCU team that is playing for bowl eligibility. However, the Horned Frogs have an interim coach and haven't looked good the last two weeks getting blown out by Oklahoma St 63-17 and nearly losing to Kansas. The Cyclones send their storied Senior class off in style.

Washington St 24 WASHINGTON 23. Washington has won 7 straight Apple Cups and have covered 6 straight meetings. Sadly, the two didn't play last year due to COVID. Both these teams have interim coaches but they are at two opposite ends of the spectrum. Washington St can win a division title with a win here and an Oregon loss. Meanwhile, Washington has nothing to play for 4-7, their first losing season since 2009. Our power ratings like Washington here but it doesn't account for the motivational differences. Totals players note the UNDER is 9-2 in Washington games this year.

UTAH 36 Colorado 16. We think this could be a tough spot for Utah here. They are off one of their biggest home wins in school history last week, a 38-7 blowout over then No. 3 Oregon on ABC Saturday night. They have the Pac-12 Championship game on deck as they try to win their first ever Pac-12 title and go to the Rose Bowl. Colorado is off an upset over Washington last week, although it was a misleading final (see page 1). Still, they haven't quit on the season and we like them here at anything over 3 TD's (we bet them +24).

Cincinnati 35 EAST CAROLINA 21. Obviously, Cincinnati kicked our butts on these pages last week as they throttled SMU getting their first ATS cover in 5 games. They moved up to No. 4 in the CFB Playoff rankings as more pressure settles in. If they win out, they would most likely become the first ever Group of 5 team in the playoff. They have a tough test here vs a ECU team that has won 4 straight games and have gone 6-1 ATS in their last 7. Their only non-cover came last week by the hook. We're passing for now but we think ECU will be the sharper side.

Saturday, November 27th

Ohio St 36 MICHIGAN 26. These two didn't meet last year. Obviously, the Buckeyes have dominated the series going 15-1 SU (+13.7 ppg) and 10-6 ATS (+6.7 ppg). The only time Michigan has beat them since 2003 came with Ohio St playing with an interim coach in 2011. The Buckeyes were super impressive last week as they throttled Michigan St 56-7 (led 49-0 at halftime). Yes, the same Michigan St team that handed the Wolverines their only loss of the season. Michigan is No. 1 in the country as far as ATS record combined with cover margin as they are 9-2 ATS with an average cover of 8.5. Can their outstanding DE's get pressure on CJ Stroud? We bet Ohio St -7 on the openers going against our power ratings. Why? Sometimes we make bets on market anticipation. We knew the whole world would want to bet Ohio St this week. How high does this spread go?

LIBERTY 30 Army 24. Liberty head coach Hugh Freeze just got a long-term contract extension making him one of the highest paid Group of 5 assistants. We bet Liberty -3 on the openers. We think their value stems from their 42-14 loss to UL-Lafayette last week. Liberty was -6 in TO's! Liberty is still No. 11 in the country in ypp margin (Army No. 78). That doesn't sound like a FG spread to us.

TENNESSEE 45 Vanderbilt 15. Don't look now but we have Tennessee up to No. 22 in our power ratings. Josh Heupel has done a really nice job in year one and now the Volunteers are playing for a better bowl destination. Meanwhile, Vanderbilt has lost 20 straight SEC games but have covered their last 3 games as clearly they haven't quit on the season. We cashed betting their UNDER in last week's game vs Ole Miss and we bet UNDER 65 on the Sunday openers.

Miami, FL 44 DUKE 23. Duke looks like they have waved the white flag on the season. They have failed to cover the spread in 5 straight games getting blown out in all 5. Their defense looked like a "Pee Wee" team trying to tackle Louisville QB Malik Cunningham last week. Meanwhile, does a blowout win here save Manny Diaz' job? Slight lean UNDER.

GEORGIA ST 30 Troy 23. Troy is playing for bowl eligibility but just fired their head coach on Sunday. Georgia St has clearly been in better form as of late with a 5-1 ATS mark and they should have covered last week vs Arkansas St. Meanwhile, Troy is just 2-6 ATS in their last 8 and we don't expect a one-game bump from the interim here.

Pittsburgh 35 SYRACUSE 25. We always talk about all of our good bets we make. How about a bad one? We bet Syracuse +11 on the openers. The thinking behind it was first and foremost, our numbers called for it. Second, we question Pitt's motivation here having clinched the ACC championship game. Third, Syracuse is playing for bowl eligibility. The Orange had covered 7 straight games but since the bye have been blown out by Louisville and NC State. We expect a better effort here.

Navy 31 TEMPLE 17. We wanted to bet Navy on the openers with our bye price being in the -10 range. We think Temple has waved the white flag on the season with 6 straight ATS losses and an overall 2-9 ATS mark on the season (-10.6 ppg). The last team you want to face with questionable effort is a service academy. With that said, we bet numbers, not teams and this line is a little higher than we would like as far as recommending a best bet on these pages. This is the first favorite role of the season for Navy. We prefer the OVER.

Wake Forest 33 BOSTON COLLEGE 30. A win and Wake Forest is in the ACC Championship game. They've played 3 straight tough games and last week were out-classed by Clemson. This is a program not used to playing with this kind of pressure. Meanwhile, Boston College was disappointing last week in their 26-23 loss to Florida St as 3-point home favorites. We lost a best bet on the OVER. We bet Boston College +5 on the openers here. We think a depth-shy Wake team is running out of gas.

West Virginia 37 KANSAS 20. West Virginia is playing for bowl eligibility here. Meanwhile, Kansas has really impressed the last two weeks. After pulling the stunner as 31-point underdogs at Texas, they nearly pulled another one last week losing in the final seconds to TCU as 3-TD underdogs. Prior to that Kansas had only covered in one game all season. Our numbers say West Virginia is the play here as Kansas still ranks No. 128 in ypp margin, No. 129 in ppg margin and No. 128 in ypp margin.

LOUISVILLE 30 Kentucky 28. We think a lot of people are surprised a 6-5 ACC team is favored over an 8-3 SEC team. We do several radio spots each week and were asked about this one in each spot. Our ratings say the right team is favored as Louisville is No. 30 in ypp margin (UK is No. 32) while the Cardinals have played the tougher schedule. Yes, that's not a mis-print, UK has benefited from an easy schedule especially in non-conference. Obviously, Louisville QB Malik Cunningham is the best player on the field. If the line went to +3.5, we would take Kentucky.

Houston 44 CONNECTICUT 13. Questionable motivation here for Houston with Cincinnati on deck. On top of it, the Cougars got banged up in last week's game vs Memphis including their starting RB Alton McCaskill (check status). Still, kudos for Dana Holgorsen getting this team to 10 straight wins. Meanwhile, 1-10 UConn is just playing out the season with an interim. We don't see much value in either the side or the total here.

RUTGERS 27 Maryland 26. Winner gets to bowl eligibility. The Terps come in reeling as they have failed to the spread in 7 straight games! They are the more explosive team (No. 88 vs No. 116 in ypp margins) but Rutgers is the much better coached team. We like the Scarlet Knights outright.

Georgia 43 GEORGIA TECH 9. Georgia Tech was completely out-manned last week vs Notre Dame in a 55-0 loss (trailed 45-0 at halftime). The GT OL couldn't hold up against the Fighting Irish front. Do you really think it can hold up here vs the best defensive line in CFB? With that being said, Georgia has bigger fish to fry on deck with a date vs Alabama in the SEC Championship game. Note Georgia will likely have the crowd edge. Slight lean UNDER.

PURDUE 31 Indiana 17. These two didn't play last year in the battle for the Old Oaken Bucket. The Hoosiers are as bad as it gets in college football as far as the point spread goes. They are 2-9 ATS failing to cover by 10.3 ppg. We cashed fading them last week in their 3-TD loss to Minnesota. Meanwhile, Purdue is looking for a better bowl destination with a win. The UNDER is 8-3 in Purdue games this year. That's where our lean is as we bet UNDER 52.5 on the Sunday openers.

VIRGINIA 34 Virginia Tech 27. Virginia Tech has dominated this series. The Hokies have gone 16-1 straight up the last 17 years. This is Virginia's largest favorite role in the series since 1992! Yes, Virginia Tech is playing for bowl eligibility. However, they have an interim coach. Virginia is off 3 straight losses and remember you have a bad data point in there with the blowout loss to Notre Dame without QB Brennan Armstrong. We wanted to bet UVA here but the line came higher than expected.

ILLINOIS 23 Northwestern 19. Northwestern has won 6 straight in this series by an average of 18.5 ppg. Obviously, that streak is going to get tested here. The Wildcats have greatly under-achieved this season while Illinois has done well in the first-year under Bielema (could be better if not for some bone-headed coaching decisions late in games). We lean Northwestern but prefer the UNDER which is 9-2 in Illinois games this year by an average of 8.8 ppg. We bet UNDER 44.5 on the Sunday openers.

TOLEDO 42 Akron 14. Statistically speaking, Toledo is the best team in the MAC. The Rockets are No. 7 in the country in ypp margin (+1.68). They were favored in 10 of their 12 games. And yet, we couldn't get to the window on OVER 7.5 wins. Sheesh! They should close the season strong here vs an Akron team playing with an interim coach. The Zips were crushed last week vs their main rival Kent St 38-0. We don't see them putting up much of a fight here.

BAYLOR 32 Texas Tech 19. An win here by Baylor and an Oklahoma St win puts the Bears in the Big 12 Championship game. Money poured in against Baylor last week as they were actually underdogs at Kansas St. They won outright 20-10 but Baylor only got a FG in the second half with the backup QB as Gerry Bohannon is questionable here. Blake Shapen completed 16 of 21 passes for 137 yards but only led the one scoring drive. Texas Tech's offense also struggled big time last week as they were shutout by Oklahoma St. Tech hadn't been shut out since 1997 ending a scoring streak of 302 consecutive games. The Red Raiders also hadn't been shut out at home since 1987 and had just 31 total yards on 28 offensive plays in the first half. We lean Tech especially if Bohannon doesn't play.

Wisconsin 23 MINNESOTA 17. The Battle for Paul Bunyan's Axe has seen Wisconsin win 16 of the last 17 meetings. A win here by the Badgers and they win the Big Ten West Division. They are one of the hottest teams in the country with 7 straight wins. The Badgers are No. 6 in ypp margin and No. 6 in ypg margin. Meanwhile, Minnesota cashed for us on these pages last week in their 35-14 win over Indiana. Two similar style of teams but the Badgers are more talented. Still, our numbers which have been pro-Wisconsin all year lean with Minnesota here. We bet OVER 37.5.

KENT ST 31 Miami, Oh 30. The winner goes to the MAC Championship game. You would think with Kent's dynamic offense that they would be better in ypp margin but Miami is No. 35 (Kent St No. 69). Miami also has better ppg and ypg margins. Our ratings have Miami as the value side but we will call for Kent St by 1. We bet UNDER 70.5 on Sunday and still lean that way.

Louisiana Tech 30 RICE 27. We bet OVER 50.5 on Sunday. Rice games are 8-3 to the OVER by 5.6 ppg. Louisiana Tech games are 8-3 to the OVER by 4.2 ppg. Neither team will be heading to a bowl and both have been disappointing this season especially La Tech who lost outright as a 15-point favorite last week to Southern Miss. We expect to see points.

2★ North Texas (plus the points) Utsa 33 NORTH TEXAS 26. We think this is a bad spot for UTSA. They're coming off back-to-back close come-from-behind wins. Last week went down to the final second as they got a thrilling TD vs UAB to clinch the West division. The Roadrunners have the CUSA Championship game on deck. Meanwhile, North Texas is playing for bowl eligibility. There's rumors that they may want to get rid of head coach Seth Littrell but the reality is the Mean Green have won 4 straight games. They have covered 5 straight. They are playing their best ball to close the season.

ARIZONA ST 34 Arizona 16. The Battle for the Territorial Cup has seen Arizona St win 4 straight including 70-7 last year (Sun Devils were +7 in TO's). That should be a rallying cry for Arizona under a first-year coach. The Sun Devils have disappointed this season mainly due to sloppy play (10 more penalties last week). We were hoping to get Arizona at +21 or greater and we settled for UNDER 53.5.

2★ Charlotte (plus the points) OLD DOMINION 31 Charlotte 25. Both teams are sitting at 5-6 so we expect to see max motivation here. ODU is better in ypp margin (No. 86 vs No. 110) but hey that's why they're laying more than a TD. They had a misleading win over Middle Tennessee last week where MT had 25-11 first down and 414-341 yard edges but were -2 in TO's. Charlotte is just 1-4 ATS in their last 5 games but ODU seems pricey here. The Monarchs were only laying 3 a couple weeks ago at a horrible FIU team.

NEW MEXICO ST 34 Massachusetts 26. This is the game we are most looking forward to this week. We're kidding of course as we have a match-up between our No. 127 rated (New Mexico St) and our No. 130 rated (UMass) teams. We like New Mexico St to cover as you're getting some value with them recently playing a pair of SEC teams while UMass last 3 games have come against a pair of FCS teams and Army. Long road trip for a UMass team playing with an interim coach.

APPALACHIAN ST 40 Georgia Southern 16. Keep an eye on the Georgia Southern QB situation. Last week starting QB Justin Tomlin did not play because of a concussion. The second-string QB, Cam Ransom, was also out with a shoulder injury. That left Cigelske and Jones taking turns under center early in the game before Cigelske took the bulk of the snaps. App St does have the Sun Belt Championship game on deck. They are rolling though with 5 straight covers. We don't see much value.

Byu 34 USC 27. Obviously after easily cashing against USC last week, we wanted to fade the Trojans again on these pages this week. We were hoping to lay a similar number with BYU as we did with UCLA last week. Note, we do have the Bruins power-rated higher than BYU so we thought it was feasible that this line would open BYU -3 or -4 even with a big downgrade on USC. The problem is now you're paying a premium wanting to fade USC this week. We lean UNDER.

3★ Cal (plus the points) UCLA 30 California 27. We like Cal here. The Bears should be max motivated needing to win their final two games to get to a bowl. Most importantly you have hidden value. The Bears have a recent bad data point (a loss to lowly Arizona). Why was that such a bad game? Well, the Bears were playing without 2 dozen players and coaches due to COVID including their QB. It was pretty much the only team in the country to have a COVID game like that this season. Everyone returned last week and they destroyed Stanford. Cal has a better ypp margin than UCLA (No. 36 vs No. 55) on the season. We think the Bruins are sitting fat and happy after last week.

OREGON 33 Oregon St 26. The most important Civil War game in several years. A win for Oregon sends the Ducks back to the Pac-12 Championship game. Oregon St needs a win and a Washington St loss to Washington. Oregon's playoff hopes died last week in Salt Lake City as they were crushed by Utah. Meanwhile, Oregon St is going bowling for the first time in nearly a decade. They beat Oregon last year as a 2-TD underdog. Statistically speaking, the teams are close as Oregon ranks No. 39 in ppg margin (Oregon St No. 41) while Oregon ranks No. 45 in ypp margin (Oregon St No. 48). We bet UNDER 67.5 on the Sunday openers. It was one of our favorite bets we made.

SOUTHERN MISS 30 Fiu 20. We wanted to bet Southern Miss in this game. These are two teams heading in opposite directions. The Wildcat QB is working for Southern Miss with back-to-back covers. They nearly outright upset UTSA and then beat Louisiana Tech as 15-point underdogs last week. Meanwhile, FIU is clearly just playing out the season with 4 straight ATS losses all in blowout fashion. FIU is a nation-worst -12.8 ATS ppg (2-9) this season. It's just tough asking Southern Miss to lay doubles now after they have been an underdog in every game vs FBS competition this year.

Notre Dame 36 STANFORD 16. Two teams heading in opposite directions. Since upsetting Oregon, Stanford is 0-6 straight up losing by an average of 20.7 ppg. The Cardinal are also 0-6 ATS failing to cover by an average of 14.3 ppg. On the other side, Notre Dame is on a 6-0 SU (+22.7 ppg) and 6-0 ATS run (+13 ppg) since losing to Cincinnati. More of the same here.

WYOMING 30 Hawaii 20. Hawaii hasn't been good on the mainland this year at 1-4 SU/ATS. They are coming off one of their better performances of the season but so is Wyoming who crushed Utah St. First thing we looked at for this game was the weather forecast. It could have been much worse for Hawaii with temps in the mid-40s and Sunshine. They lost in the cold here last year 31-7 as 1-point underdogs. We bet OVER 45.

OKLAHOMA ST 28 Oklahoma 24. One of the most important Bedlam games ever. Oklahoma is on a 16-2 SU and 12-5-1 ATS run in the series. However, this Oklahoma St defense is legit. The Cowboys are No. 3 in ypp allowed, No. 3 in ypg allowed and No. 2 in scoring. They just handed Texas Tech their first shutout since 1997, a span of 302 games! Oklahoma St has covered 9 straight games. A win here and a win next week in the Big 12 title game could send them to the playoffs (they'll need some help). Oklahoma's offense has struggled the last two weeks and we think they will again here.

SMU 33 Tulsa 28. Is this the last game at SMU for Sonny Dykes? There is plenty of smoke about him taking the TCU job. Obviously, we lost on these pages backing SMU last week as they were crushed by Cincinnati. Meanwhile, Tulsa is playing for bowl eligibility. They have the better ypp margin (No. 50 vs No. 59) and have played the tougher schedule.

Alabama 38 AUBURN 18. The game has lost a ton of luster with Auburn losing 3 straight games and QB Bo Nix for the season. There's also a lot of off-field smoke surrounding head coach Bryan Harsin. With that being said, we haven't been overwhelmed with Alabama this season. We'd actually favor both Georgia and Ohio St over them and remember the Tide have been an underdog only one time since 2009! What is Alabama's reason for significant margin here? They have the game of the year on deck vs Georgia. We're not involved on either side or total.

MEMPHIS 33 Tulane 27. Memphis needs this game for bowl eligibility. Meanwhile, Tulane might be 2-9 but the Green Wave are coming off their best performance of the season, a blowout win over USF and they have covered 3 of their last 4 games with the only non-cover being an OT loss to Tulsa as 3-point underdogs. Memphis is 2-6 ATS in their last 8 games. We lean OVER.

Clemson 29 SOUTH CAROLINA 16. Clemson has won 6 straight in the series but unfortunately the two didn't play last year due to COVID. The Tigers are coming off their best performance of the season, a 21-point win over Top 10 Wake Forest. Meanwhile, South Carolina clinched bowl eligibility with an upset over Auburn. We were hoping to bet Clemson here but once again, the line came out -14 which we thought was way too pricey. We did take OVER 41.5.

Western Kentucky 37 MARSHALL 36. The winner goes to the CUSA Championship game next week. This is a really underrated match-up as Marshall rankings No. 9 in the country in ypp margin while WKU ranks No. 8. We have upgraded WKU more than any team in the country in our power ratings since the start of the season. The Hilltoppers have won 6 straight games by an average of 25.5 ppg going 5-1 ATS in the process. We bet UNDER 79.5 on the openers and still have a slight lean that way.

Penn St 27 MICHIGAN ST 25. We think Penn St is the right side here. The Nittany Lions have been banged up as of late but they seem to be healthier heading into this one. Is Michigan St RB Kenneth Walker healthy? Didn't look like it last week. His injury was the least of MSU's problems as their pass defense was torched allowing 49 points in the first half to Ohio St! "We got blasted," Michigan State coach Mel Tucker said. Both coaches look like they have locked up long-term lucrative contracts in recent weeks (Tucker hasn't been officially announced). MSU needs this for a possible Fiesta Bowl berth. They don't get it.

3★ Florida St 29 FLORIDA 28. We like Florida St here. It's a rivalry game and both teams are going for bowl eligibility. However, the overall vibe around FSU is much better. "It sets us up for a huge week ahead," Florida State coach Mike Norvell said. "They've battled back to this point. We're 0-and-4 at the beginning of the season, not many people gave us a chance. We're going into this week with an opportunity to win one more and that's special." "It means everything," QB Jordan Travis said of the chance to make a bowl. Meanwhile, Florida has an interim coach. Remember Dan Mullen was the play-caller and

the Gators already fired their offensive line coach and their defensive coordinator a couple games ago. The Gators are 3-8 ATS failing to cover by 9.9 ppg. They failed to cover in 5 straight. Noles outright!

Texas A&M 29 LSU 20. The question here is what are we getting from LSU. Are they going to play inspired (like the Alabama game) in the final game for Ed Orgeron or are we getting a lack-luster effort like last week's 27-14 win over ULM. Texas A&M is No. 12 in the country in ypp margin, LSU is No. 87. We're surprised the line isn't 7. It will be a good in-game live opportunity to see what LSU's motivation is.

UL-LAFAYETTE 37 UL-Monroe 17. ULL is on a 11-2 SU run in the series. However, it's a tough spot for them off a big win over Liberty thanks to a +6 TO margin. That 42-14 final was misleading creating some value. The Cajuns also have the Sun Belt Championship game on deck and are dealing with the possible loss of their head coach to a bigger job. ULM has already pulled 3 huge upsets this year. Can they pull another? We'll take the 21 and the hook.

ARKANSAS ST 31 Texas St 29. Two teams just playing out the season. Texas St is a little better in ypp margin (No. 107 vs No. 123) but Arkansas St has played the tougher schedule. Totals' players note that when you think of Arkansas St, you probably think bad defense. The reality is each of their last 6 games have went UNDER the total.

FLORIDA ATLANTIC 30 Middle Tennessee 23. Two teams playing for bowl eligibility. We're a little surprised how short this line is. Middle Tennessee is again playing with a 3rd string QB. Maybe the 50-10 win over FIU from the other week is hiding that. MT has the better full-season stats including No. 74 in ypp margin (FAU is No. 84). However, we like FAU.

Nevada 31 COLORADO ST 26. We lean Nevada here. Colorado St's season took a turn for the worse in the final seconds of the Utah St game. And then head coach Addazio threw the players' under the bus. They've responded to by failing to cover in 5 straight games. Nevada has the better ypp margin (No. 52 vs No. 66) and get to 8 wins.

For the past five seasons we have posted computer projected lines for every game. **Games where there was of difference of more than 3 points saw our computer lines actually beat the Vegas line at a 373-302-12 (55%) including an outstanding 71-50 (59%) last year! Last week's plays went 2-2 and are 44-46 on the season.** That's still pretty solid and actually better than our own handicapping in some seasons. Keep in mind, these computer lines don't take into consideration off-the-field factors like revenge or flat spots. They are basically a power-rating number difference between the two teams that also takes into consideration the home field advantage.

Of the 10 games where our computer is off more than 3 points compared to the Vegas line (highlighted), our favorite team this week to back would be **Charlotte +9.5**.

The Comp column is the computer projected line and the Diff column is the difference between the Vegas line and the Computer line. "+" numbers in the difference column say back the underdog. "-" numbers in the difference column say back the favorite. Let us know if you have questions.

HOME TEAM IN CAPS

Thursday, November 25th

Chicago 20 DETROIT 19. This is the 19th time these two have played on Thanksgiving. Obviously, the Lions come in winless but their locker-room arguably is in better shape than the Bears as we hear whispers of head coach Matt Nagy being on the chopping block soon. The Bears are 0-5 SU and 1-4 ATS in their last 5 games. It looks like we could be getting a Andy Dalton vs Tim Boyle QB matchup here. We recommend you eat Thanksgiving dinner early and watch the later games. Despite their winless record, the Lions are 6-4 ATS and we like them to cover here as well as the UNDER. **DALLAS 29 Las Vegas 21.** Since their bye, the Raiders are 0-3 SU (-17.7 ppg) and 0-3 ATS (-17.2 ppg). With an interim coach and so many off-field distractions, this looks like a team on the brink of total collapse. Meanwhile, the Cowboys offense is banged up especially at WR and Dallas failed to get to the end zone in their loss to the Chiefs last week. Dallas is just 2-10 ATS in their last 12 Thanksgiving games. We don't see a lot of value here.

Buffalo 26 NEW ORLEANS 20. A lot of the early week money has come in on the Bills in this one. The Saints will likely be without RB Alvin Kamara, TE Adam Trautman, LT Terron Armstead, G Andrus Peat, and RT Ryan Ramczyk. New Orleans has lost 3 straight and it doesn't look like it will get better anytime soon. Meanwhile, the Bills either look like the best team in the NFL or a well-below average team. According to Football Outsiders (advanced metrics) The Bills now have a week-to-week DVOA variance of 46.6%. The current record is 38.2% for the 2005 San Francisco 49ers. The Bills are, quite literally, the most inconsistent team in Football Outsiders history (30-plus years). Not sure we want to bet into that variance.

Sunday, November 28th

NEW ENGLAND 25 Tennessee 19. New England is on a 5-0 SU (+25 ppg) and 5-0 ATS (+21.7 ppg) run! The defense is playing at an elite level and Belichick has extra time to prep for this one. Last week we cashed on these pages fading the Titans as they lost outright as a double-digit favorite to Houston. Tennessee is banged up as they had a league-high 20 players on IR last week and not having RB Derrick Henry is really starting to show. The bye week can't get here soon enough for them.

HOUSTON 24 N.Y. Jets 21. We cashed on these pages with Houston last week in their outright upset over Tennessee as 10-point underdogs. Quite simply, they are a different team with Tyrod Taylor under center as they have a +17 point differential. Meanwhile, the Jets are a league-worst 2-8 ATS and their defense has allowed 40 ppg in their last 5. We don't care who starts at QB for them, we don't want them in this one. Then again, it's tough laying points with a Houston team that has been at least a 3.5-point underdog or more in every game until this week. Pass.

Philadelphia 26 N.Y. GIANTS 21. We say this every week but no team in the NFL gets more money than the Eagles. If you want to bet on them, you need to bet them early in the week to get the best number. Last week they crushed the Saints as QB Hurts became the first Eagles QB with 3 rushing TD's in a game. They have rushed for at least 175 yards in 4 straight games (first time since 1950). When you look at the Eagles' upcoming schedule, they will be favored in their next 5 games and then could face a Dallas team resting starters in Week 18. Barring a collapse, this could be a playoff team. The same can't be said for the Giants who just got beat up on MNF and proceeded to fire OC Jason Garrett.

Tampa Bay 28 INDIANAPOLIS 25. Tampa comes in after the win and cover over the Giants on MNF to get their season back on track. Meanwhile, after an 0-3 start, the Colts are on a 6-2 SU/ATS run highlighted by last week's blowout win over the Bills (we cashed the OVER on these pages). RB Jonathan Taylor is making

a strong push for MVP. He had 5 TD's last week and has had 8 straight games with 100-plus scrimmage yards and a TD. The problem for Taylor and the Colts is that Tampa has one of the best run defenses in the NFL. Slight lean OVER.

JACKSONVILLE 23 Atlanta 22. It doesn't get much worse than what the Falcons have done the last two weeks getting beat by a combined 68-3. Meanwhile, Jacksonville's offense has averaged just 10.8 ppg the last 4 weeks. Trevor Lawrence has gone 3 straight games without a TD pass! The UNDER has cashed in 4 straight Jacksonville games. That's where our lean is.

MIAMI 21 Carolina 20. The Dolphins come in winners of 3 straight. Their defense has allowed just 12 ppg in those 3 wins. They have 3 straight home games against the Panthers, Giants and Jets and now remarkably could be looking at a near .500 record entering the final weeks. Meanwhile, even though they signed QB Cam Newton and paired him with a healthy RB McCaffrey the Panthers fell to Washington last week. Newton has given their offense a little spark but when he starts the game, the Panthers have lost 9 straight. We have a lean on Miami.

2★ Pittsburgh (plus the points) CINCINNATI 23 Pittsburgh 21. Cincinnati is taking some money in this match-up. The Bengals dominated the 4Q in their win in Vegas last week to move to 6-4. Pittsburgh is on a 11-2 run vs Cincinnati but one of those losses came in Week 3 with Cincinnati winning 24-10. In the Tomlin era, Pittsburgh is 44-22-3 ATS as an underdog. Despite their regression since the end of last season, the Steelers are 4-1 ATS as an underdog this year and we think they get to the window once again.

DENVER 23 L.A. Chargers 22. Denver comes in off the bye while the Chargers are off a thrilling SNF game. The Broncos are just 2-5 SU/ATS since their 3-0 start but have won 7 of the last 8 times they've hosted the Chargers. This fits one of our handicapping staples...backing a defensive home underdog. Denver outright.

2★ Minnesota 25 SAN FRANCISCO 24. The 49ers are now .500 after back-to-back easy wins and covers. Minnesota has also won 2 straight (covered 3 straight) to get to .500 as this is an important game in the NFC with regards to the playoffs. The Vikings have lost just one game by more than 4 points and that was by 7 to Cleveland. It's tough to get margin on them. Also Levi's Stadium has not been friendly to the 49ers this year as they are 0-4 ATS and 0-4 SU as a home favorite! Again!

GREEN BAY 24 L.A. Rams 23. Huge NFC playoff implications here and the two did meet here in the playoffs last year (32-18 win for GB). The Rams really needed that bye after back-to-back losses. L.A. was also on a 0-4 ATS run. Meanwhile, Green Bay's 9-game ATS win streak went up in flames last week as they lost outright to the Vikings on the final play. The question here is the status of Aaron Rodgers' toe. Does he risk scrambling around vs Aaron Donald and Company?

2★ BALTIMORE 26 Cleveland 20. Cleveland is off a very lack-luster performance vs a Lions teams playing with a back-up QB. Obviously, Baker Mayfield doesn't look 100%. Speaking of less than 100%, Lamar Jackson sat out last week's game vs Chicago and backup QB Tyler Huntley led the game-winning drive late over the Bears. Lamar should be back for this one and we like Baltimore.

Monday, November 29th

WASHINGTON 23 Seattle 21. We can't believe we lost a teaser with the Seahawks on these pages last week. It was like a super-teaser considering we played it before Kyler Murray was ruled out for the Cardinals. Now at 3-7, in the toughest division in the NFL, you have to wonder if Seattle keeps trotting a less than 100% Russell Wilson out there. He has 0 TD's in the two games back from his broken finger. The Seahawks are off to their worst start since 2009 (the year before Pete Carroll). Meanwhile, Washington has to be feeling better off back-to-back wins. Lean Washington and the UNDER.
