RSVPs are REQUIRED, so we can be sure to have enough meals on hand! \*



# **Energy Star Scores and April Building Tour**

The Going Green committee is currently gathering Energy Star scores of buildings in San Antonio to compare against other cities in Texas. We have received responses from Robert Andrews, Sr., John Cauley, Doug Graves, Rex Poppy, Kyle Riggs, Kenny Taylor, and Jock Tilghman. Guess whose building has a high score of 94? If you would like your building's Energy Star score to be included in the published findings, please e-mail it to me at lasater.tom@att.net. And, if there is enough interest, we will schedule a roundtable discussion between engineers whose buildings have an Energy Star score and those that would like to achieve this.

If you missed our April building tour, it was held at Oak Hills Church where Doyle Jennings is the Plant and Construction Engineer. This building has about 150,000 square feet of space, and about 133,000 square feet of that is air

conditioned. To conserve energy and save money, the building is on CPS Energy's Demand Response program. Through this program, the demand meter from CPS feeds into the building's Automated Logic AC control system. The program changes the temperature settings in the building to reduce demand. This can be done for each thermostat so that critical rooms are kept at a stable temperature while allowing other room temperatures to change without being uncomfortable. As a side note, the Demand Response (DR) program with Open DR and Auto DR may become mandatory as our energy demands outgrow our current energy grid supply.




It's hard to believe we are already in April! I hope everyone has been enjoying this spring weather while you can. The 100 degree days of summer are right around the corner.
