## LLOYD R. FINKBEINER 1914 - 1995

Lloyd R. Finkbeiner, 81, longtime Cass City resident and since 1993 of Sebausing, died Thursday afternoon, Dec. 21, in his home in Lakeland, PL, following an illness of

four years.
