Rules and information for coaches, players and parents.

- **Rules:** Except where noted, Minnesota High School Association rules apply.
- **Time:** Grades (5 – 6 – 7 – 8) 14 minute stop time halves Halftime break: 5 minutes

Running time will be in effect in the last half of the second half if a team is ahead by 20 or more points. (At the 7 minute mark.) The referee might stop the clock on free throws if the time permits. If the margin drops below 20 points, stop time is again in effect. Timeouts stop the clock in running time.

- **Timeouts:** 3 one minute timeouts per game, one additional timeout for all of overtime, but no carryover of timeouts from regulation into overtime.
- **Overtime:** 2 minute stop time for first O.T., sudden death, first point wins for second overtime.
- **Fouls:** Will become 1 and 1 (bonus) on the 7th foul per half. Two shots on 10 fouls or more.
- **Defensive Rules:** 6th - 7th - 8th grades *All types of defenses allowed
- 5th grade * Man to man half court only. No pressing, no zone defenses allowed
No team may full court press if ahead by 15 points or more. Referees may give a team a technical if team continues to press after being warned. Less than 15 points, you can press again.
- **Awards:** All awards are based on a 10 player roster.
- **Miscellaneous:**
 - Teams must have 5 players to start a game.
 - No protests – conflicts will be settled on the floor by the officials/tournament official.
 - Please bring your own warm up balls and a good game ball.
 - Maximum of two coaches on bench. Must stay in bench area. Two coaches admitted free.
 - Technical fouls will be shot.
 - No Tournament cancellation or refund.
 - No hard casts may be worn.
 - **Flip of the coin will determine home team. Home team will provide an official scorer.**
